Your project must fall under one of Rotary's Six Areas of Focus. Which fits your project best? (See more here: <https://www.rotary.org/en/our-causes>)

Give an accurate timeline of the project. It MUST be completed by June 1, 2020.

Who will the project involve? You MUST include one other dues-paying club member to partake in your project. (Non-dues-paying club members and/or non-Boston Rotaract friends are welcome to join in addition.) Please list any organizations you plan to partner with.

Receipts for reimbursement and at least one photo MUST be submitted once your project is complete. Please initial that you will understand and will send these.
