Last year the Claremont RSL sub-Branch raised about \$4K, and hopefully our Rotary efforts will help them surpass that amount this year. The RSL is also planning a BBQ at the Claremont Showground on Wednesday 11 November, and a bugler from Churchlands Senior High will do the honours at 11.00 am. David was accompanied by his wife Sharon and by Alan Wilson, President of the Cambridge RSL sub-Branch, and we were glad to see John Travlos again and Honorary Member Jeanette Wood.
