





GUEST SPEAKER: MAESTRO HANS GRAF TOPIC: ORCHESTRAS AND SOCIETY IN DIFFICULT TIMES

President Louis invited Rtn Jens Ruebbert to introduce the Speaker, Maestro Hans Graf who assumed the title of Chief Conductor of the Singapore Symphony Orchestra since July 2020. His collaboration with the SSO has been described as "solidly musical" (Bachtrack) and an "inspired partnership" (The Straits Times). Maestro Graf was formerly Music Director of the Houston Symphony (2001–2013). He has appeared with most major orchestras in the US, Canada and in Europe. He is a regular guest with the Sydney and Melbourne Symphony Orchestras, the Seoul, Hong Kong and Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestras. A frequent conductor at the Salzburg Festival since 1983, Graf has also participated in many festivals and has led many performances at the Vienna State Opera since 1981, and at the opera houses of Munich, Berlin, Paris and Rome, among others. He is a Chevalier

de l'Ordre de la Légion d'honneur and was awarded the Grand Decoration of Honour of the Republic of Austria.

In his talk, Maestro Graf shared his personal views on various aspects and orchestra differences in Singapore and in the region, the competitive nature of orchestras as well as politics in the world of music. He spoke of the history of European music and its composers. Maestro Graf gave invaluable insights on leadership of orchestras based on his illustrious career and experience. To conclude his talk, Maestro Graf graciously answered queries posed to him by members attending the meeting physically as well as virtually.


