# **Introduction of DGN Dr Shahul Hameed**

Prior to DGN Shahul's Acceptance Speech, PP Stan Low introduced DGN Shahul. Following is an excerpt of the introduction for the benefit of newer members ...

Dr Shahul Hameed's journey with Rotary began 29 years ago when he embarked on a path of service by joining the Rotary Club of Singapore in 1995. Since then, his unwavering dedication has left an indelible mark on countless lives, both within our Rotary family and beyond.

A dentist by profession, Dr Shahul not only tends to the health of smiles but also nurtures the well-being of communities. His passion for service extends far beyond the confines of his dental practice, permeating every

aspect of his life. As Club President during the Rotary Year 2013/2014, Dr Shahul exemplified the true spirit of Rotary, leading with compassion, integrity, and an unwavering commitment to making a difference.

Dr Shahul's impact extend far beyond his Rotary Club. He is also an Adjunct Senior Lecturer with the Faculty of Dentistry, National University of Singapore, Council Member with the Singapore Dental Council, and Member of the Panel of Advisers, for the Family Justice Courts, Republic of Singapore. Dr Shahul is passionate in shaping the future of his profession and dedicated to his commitment to justice and welfare for his community.

Dr Shahul was also an eminent grassroots leader in Singapore, serving as District Councillor as well as Member of the School Advisory Committees of both Victoria School and Victoria Junior College for 10 consecutive years.

Yet, Dr Shahul's influence transcends borders. He has etched his name in history as the first Asian to preside over the International Association of Dental Students and later, as the youngest President of the Asia Pacific Dental Federation. He later became the youngest inductee to be included the Dental Federation's List of Honour.

Within Rotary, Dr Shahul has taken on various leadership roles and made a substantial impact at both the district and international levels. Over the years, he has held several key positions within the district, including Chair for District Rotary Foundation (DRFC), Chair for Grants, Stewardship, Scholarship, International Service and Rotaract. In 2017, Dr Shahul became the first Rotarian from District 3310 to be appointed as Member of the Rotary Foundation's "Cadre of Technical Advisers".

Dr Shahul's primary interest is leveraging on Rotary's Global Grants for Community Projects and Missions. To date, he has assisted RC Singapore, District 3310 and Clubs in the region, in the application of more than 230 Global Grants. As of today, RC Singapore itself has had 165 Global Grants approved. This demonstrated his relentless commitment to serving humanity through our Rotary Foundation.

In recognition for his contributions to the Community, and for his work with Global Grants, Dr Shahul has been conferred Honorary Memberships to 13 Rotary Clubs around the world. Namely:

3 in Indonesia, 8 in India, 2 in Philippines.

Perhaps what truly sets Dr Shahul apart is his ability to inspire others to join him in the pursuit of Rotary's noble mission. His passion is infectious, his vision compelling, and his dedication unwavering. As an invited speaker at Rotary Foundation Seminars across multiple countries including Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, Taiwan, Philippines, Nigeria, Pakistan and India, and a Plenary Speaker at Rotary's International Assembly, Dr Shahul has

touched the hearts and minds of Rotarians around the globe, igniting a fire of service and compassion that knows no bounds.

Dr Shahul is the recipient of Rotary International's highest Award, the "Service Above Self" Award, the Rotary Foundation's highest Award, the "Distinguished Service Award", the Rotary Foundation's "Citation for Meritorious Service Award", the Rotary International's "Avenues of Service Award" as well as the Republic of Singapore's "Public Service Medal".

Dr Shahul is married to Michelle and is Father to 19-year-old son, Mirza Hameed. When availing himself as a candidate to the District Nominating Committee for the position of Governor for District 3310 for Rotary Year 2025-2026, Dr Shahul presented the following manifesto: That as Governor for District 3310, he will seek to further strengthen, support and motivate Clubs in the Ideals of Service by enhancing knowledge and encouraging the creation of lasting change, while espousing the spirit of giving to uplift our Rotary Foundation.

# **Meeting Report**

### 36<sup>th</sup> Weekly Meeting for Rotary Year 2023/2024 held on 29.5.2024.

#### **Distinguished Guest Speaker Series**

#### Speaker: Her Excellency (H E) Madiepetsane Charlotte Lobe, High Commissioner of the Republic of South Africa in Singapore

President Siew Luen invited PP Stan Low to introduce HE Madiepetsane Charlotte Lobe who was formerly Acting Chief Operations Officer of the Department of International Relations and Cooperation. She holds a Master's Degree in Politics, majoring in Governance and Political Transformation from the University of the Free State, South Africa, as well as Diploma in Public Relations and Communication from the Damelin Business School, South Africa.

HE Charlotte Lobe previously served as the National Spokesperson for the African National Congress' Women's League. She was also the President of the African Women Leaders Network, South Africa, the Convener of the Gertrude Shope Women Mediators Network, and the Co-Convener of the South African Women's Peace Table. At international fora, HE Charlotte Lobe served in the Global Network of National Focal Points on Women, Peace and Security, where she co-chaired the Network on behalf of South Africa. She also served on the Global Steering Committee of the Generation Equality Forum, a multi-generational initiative aimed at dismantling gender inequalities and achieving a gender-equal world by 2030.

HE Charlotte Lobe has served in several leadership positions in government, including as a Councillor from 1996 to 1999 at the local government level, as a Member of Parliament from 1999 to 2004, and as a Member of the Free State Provincial Legislature from 2004 to 2008.

HE Charlotte Lobe gave a succinct talk which highlighted the vibrancy of her country. She noted the presence of South African missions in many countries in order to develop better friendships as well as to strengthen bilateral trade particularly with ASEAN. She spoke of the country's investment opportunities and its wide-ranging industries including wine-producing, proximity to the animal kingdom and natural beauty.


