Strong Relationship Between India and Singapore

India and Singapore have built a long history of strong bilateral relations. What are the key challenges and future prospects for India-Singapore ties? How can these two nations further strengthen their partnership? Dr. Shilpak Ambule will provide valuable insights into this relationship.

High Commissioner of India

His Excellency Dr. Shilpak Ambule

Rtn Grace:

Dr. Shilpak Ambule, High Commissioner of India to Singapore, was the guest speaker at the Rotary meeting on December 4th, discussing "The Strong Relationship Between India and Singapore."

He began by highlighting India's positive changes over the past decade, such as digital banking reforms, infrastructure growth (e.g., a doubling of airports to 149), and a focus on workforce upskilling. He noted that the Indian government is keen on attracting investment and improving skills, especially in sectors like semiconductors.

Dr. Ambule then discussed the bilateral relationship between India and Singapore, noting Prime Minister Modi's admiration for Lee Kuan Yew and frequent visits to Singapore. He mentioned new joint roundtable discussions in 2024, including digital remittances, connectivity, tech education, sustainability, health research, and semiconductor development.

He also highlighted military cooperation, including Singaporean military training in India and Indian vessels using Singapore waters. Dr. Ambule stressed the importance of this partnership for India's ASEAN relations.

During the Q&A, he addressed issues such as stock market speculation, property speculation, tensions in Manipur, and the return of Indian talent, noting that the government is actively managing migration. He expressed interest in collaboration with Rotary on government initiatives.

Rtn Uttam Kripalani closed the session with a vote of thanks, praising Dr. Ambule's communication skills.
