Who we are

Scholars of Sustenance Foundation Thailand is a registered non-profit organization operating to tackle the food waste and food insecurity problem in Thailand since 2016. We rescue good quality surplus food from restaurants, hotels, retailers, and food manufacturers seven days a week and distribute them to different communities in need (instead of being thrown away in different landfills). We aim to distribute **25 million meals by 2025** by increasing our operation and capacity thru establishing a Foodbank and distribution nodes around Thailand.



How SOS was established?

A business trip in Asia totally changed the whole retirement plan for Bo Holmgreen, a Danish national, former CEO of Transoft Solutions Inc., as he saw how abundant food gets thrown in the trash that ends up in the landfills while seeing many people not having access to good food. He then established SOS in the US in 2012 which later formed as a food rescue foundation we know today.



2016

SOS was first established in **BANGKOK**, Thailand and where we started the food rescue operation



2017

SOS expanded immediately in another Asian country and launched the food rescue operation in **BALI**, Indonesia



2019 & 2020

Thailand found regional expansion opportunities and managed to open in **PHUKET**, Thailand last 2019, then **HUA HIN**, Thailand in 2020

1 Sign up hospitality, retailers, and suppliers to donate food



2 Provide food safety handling training and preparation guidelines to donors



3 Schedule food donation collection and inspect the quality of food



4 Transport the surplus food to the community on the same day



5 Give the nutritious surplus food to the recipients



6 Track and report donation data to donors






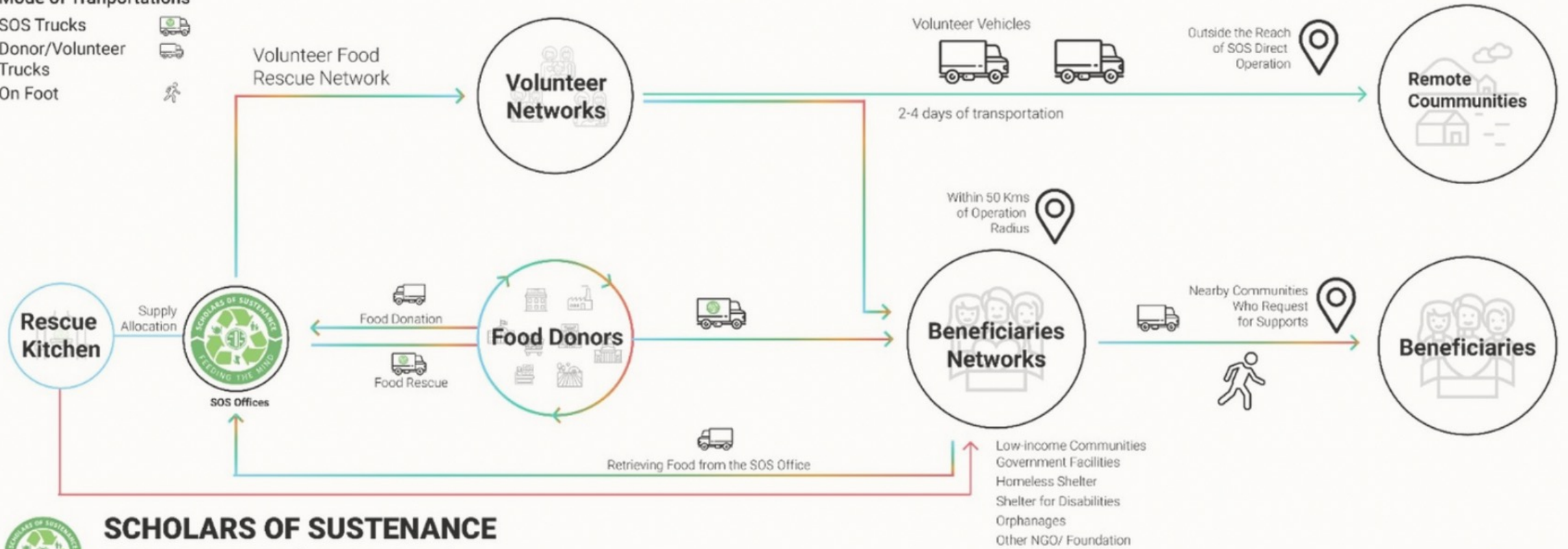

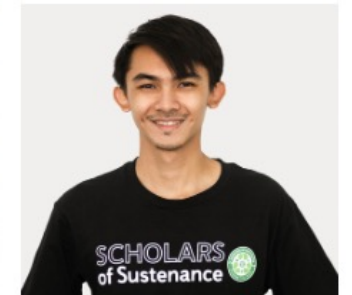


DONOR REPORT

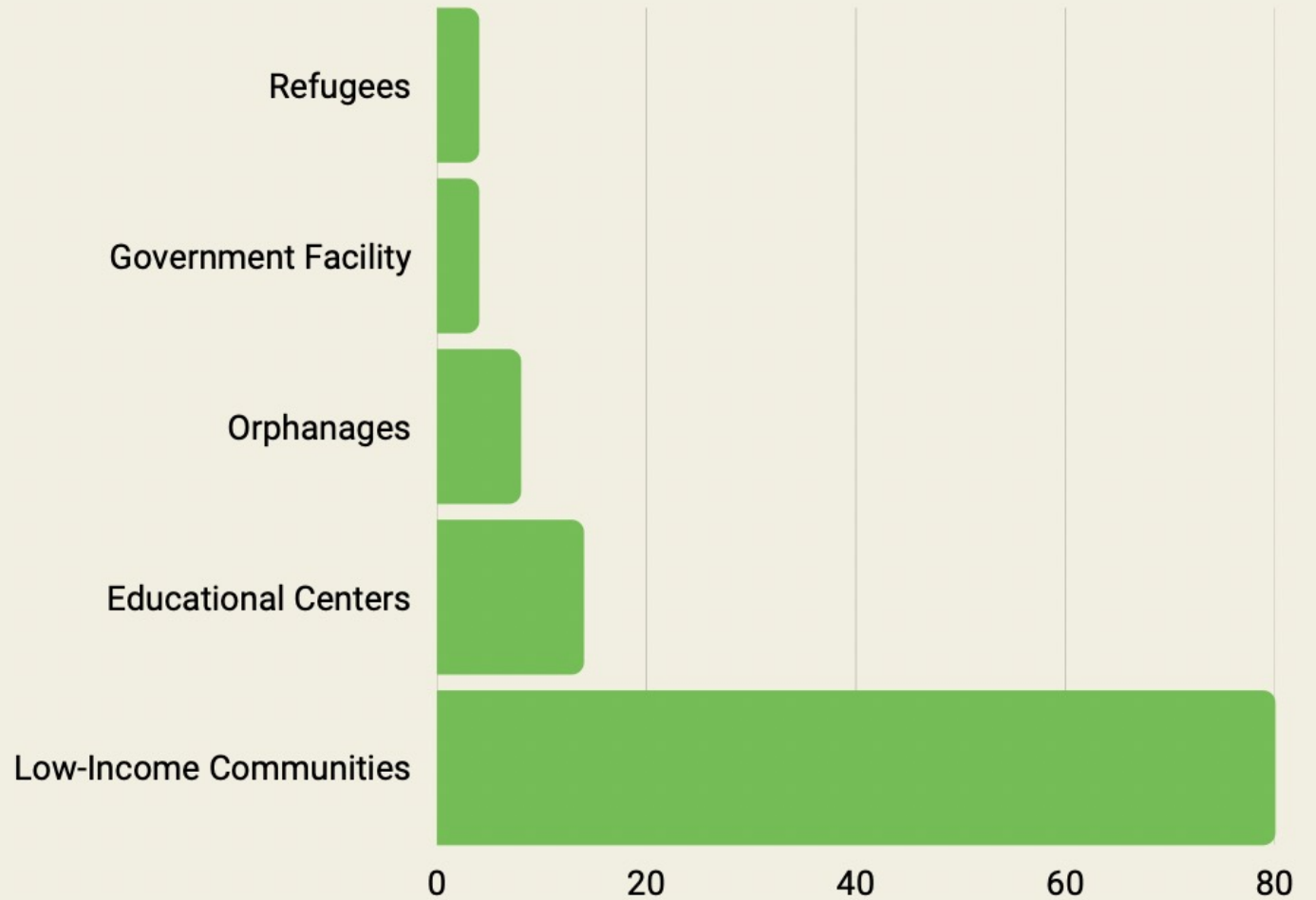

*SOS targets and identifies vulnerable communities especially the **elderly**, the **disabled**, **women**, **kids**, **neglected** and **disadvantaged** groups in the society.*

Recipient Breakdown

We use our "Recipient Urgency Indicator System" that allows us to identify which recipient/communities needs more urgent food than the others, and understands the type of food supply they need, nutritional requirements, plus any food restrictions.

FOOD REPURPOSING X COMMUNITY KITCHEN

A smart food program that repurposes some rescued food ingredients and transforms them into a nutritious meal, served to vulnerable communities 4-5 times a week. SOS buys the additional ingredients for added nutrition and the community volunteers cook, together with different volunteers distribute to different communities.

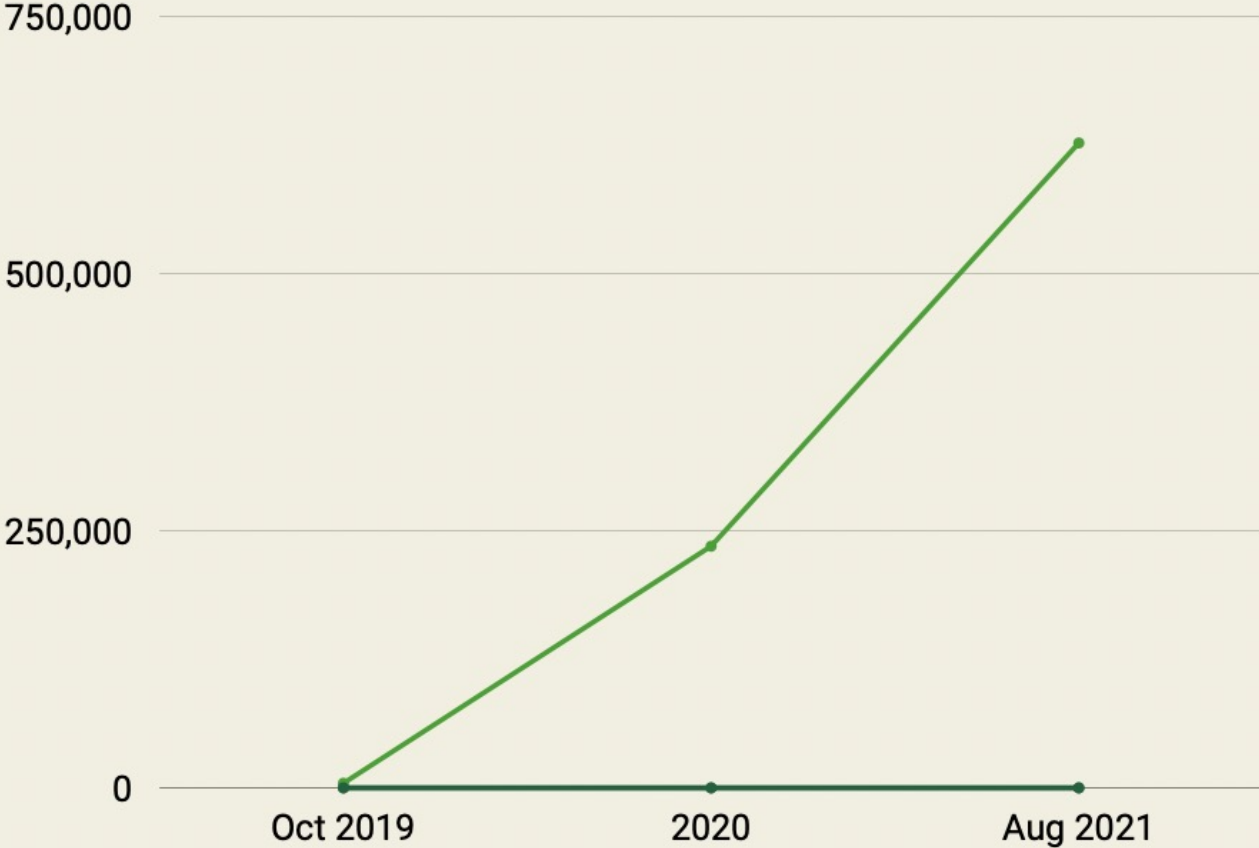


COOK FOR SOS PROGRAM

A cooking activity for those who want to help but are afraid to participate in Community Kitchen activities for safety reasons. A great way to share your passion for cooking while helping others at the comfort of your home together with your whole family. SOS will take care of the pick-up and distribution to the communities.

Yearly Food Operation Progress

We opened slowly in 2019, then started picking up in Q1 of 2020 until the pandemic happened which derailed the growth plan we had for the whole year. But in 2021, despite the existing pandemic challenge, we found different ways on how we can increase our operation so we can expand our reach to help as many communities in need.

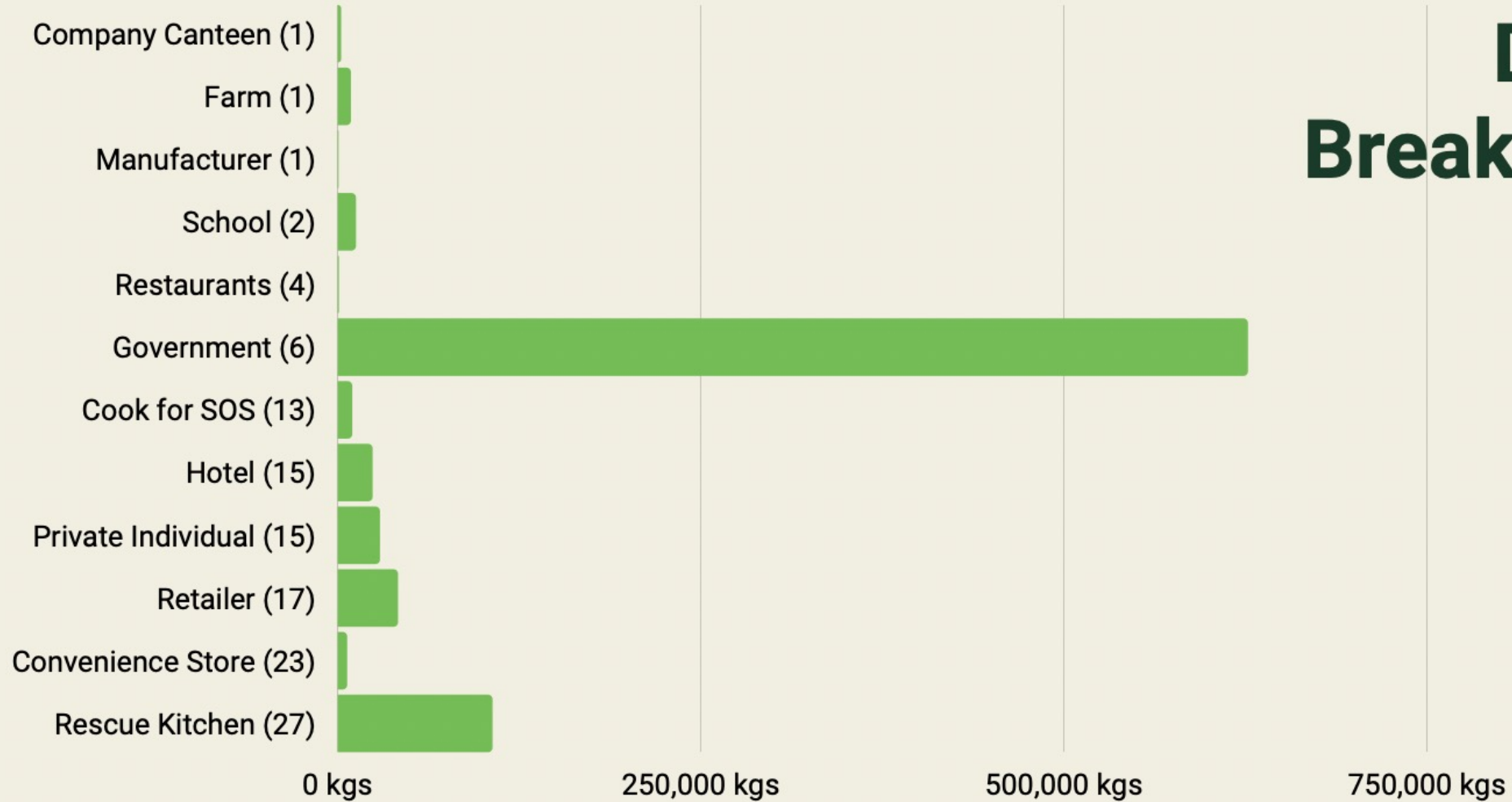
