Neil Black, District Governor 2020–21 invites you to the last 9600 Conference, in his home town of Kingaroy, Queensland, from 26 –28 March 2021. Building on the theme “*Outside the box*” the conference focuses on the contribution Rotary makes to the wider community and the challenges we will confront as we embrace the future.



KINGAROY is an agricultural town and locality in the South Burnett Region, Queensland, Australia. It is approximately 210 kilometres or about 2½ hours drive north-west of the state capital, Brisbane. The town is situated on the junction of the D’Aguilar and the Bunya Highways. It is known as the “Peanut Capital of Australia” with Australia’s largest peanut processing plant being located in the town and peanut silos dominate the skyline. The town and surrounds boast wineries, lavender



farm and a multitude of historical and unique eating opportunities. Kingaroy is also home to the largest pork processing facility in the Southern Hemisphere.

Kingaroy has a vibrant cultural and social life, home to an art gallery and several local craft outlets as well as a range of well-maintained and attractive parklands. The town has two lookouts (at Mt Wooroolin and Apex Park in Fisher Street) that provide striking panoramic views across the area.



ACCOMODATION: A list of accommodation sites can be found on the conference website. They vary from caravan parks, to B&Bs and motels. Home hosting is a possibility. Get in early and book your choice.

DINNERS: Friday night we are the guests of the Bjelke Petersen family at their property, Bethany.

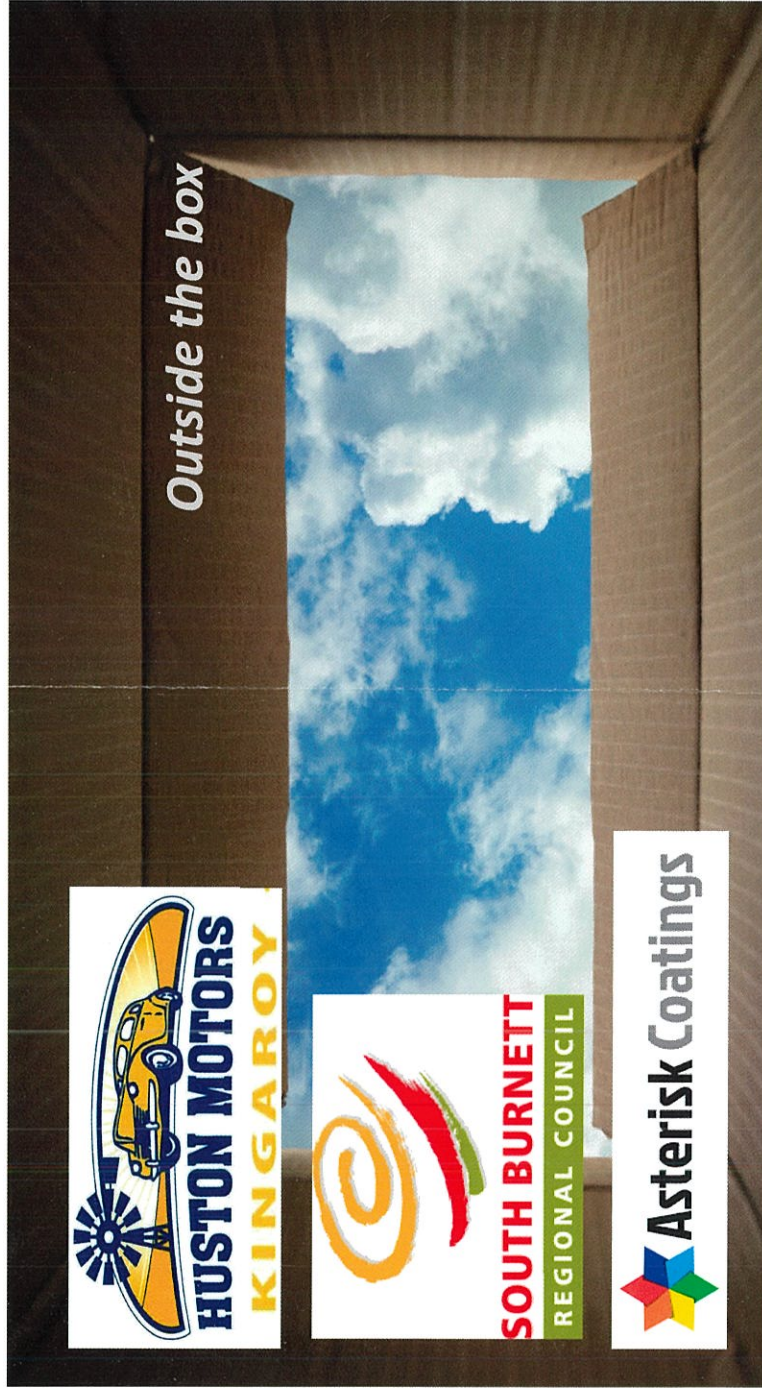
