As a school guidance counsellor, Kassie Bromley is used to shaping young minds. Now as a PHD candidate at UniSC's Thompson Institute she's back in schools – this time shaping brains – with a new pilot Program.

The Brain Changer workshops focus on teaching teenagers how five modifiable lifestyle factors – nutrition, sleep, exercise, mindfulness and social connectedness – can physically shape their brains and improve mental health.

"Often we work with reactive approaches to treating mental health disorders. But if we can implement proactive measures, we can safeguard adolescent brains and

hopefully intervene before mental health difficulties emerge," she said. The Brain Changer workshops use neuroscience about how teenagers make decisions, to help shape the workshops and increase the likelihood of students adopting them. The workshops are also full of engaging neuroscience content which is made relatable for teenagers.
