- Why the Caloundra main street is called Bulcock Street?
- Who first settled Caloundra?
- What was Caloundra like during WW 2?
- What shops were in Bulcock Street in the early days?
- Where was the first dwelling in Bulcock Street?

All these questions and more will be answered when you join a Heritage Walking tour of Bulcock Street.

From the top of Town, Cnr Canberra Tce & Bulcock Street down to Felicity Park discover what Caloundra looked like, who were the entrepreneurs, what was life like in the early days of settlement and the start of Tourism in Caloundra. A 500 metre stroll down Bulcock Street for about an hour with a guide who will tell you stories, answer your

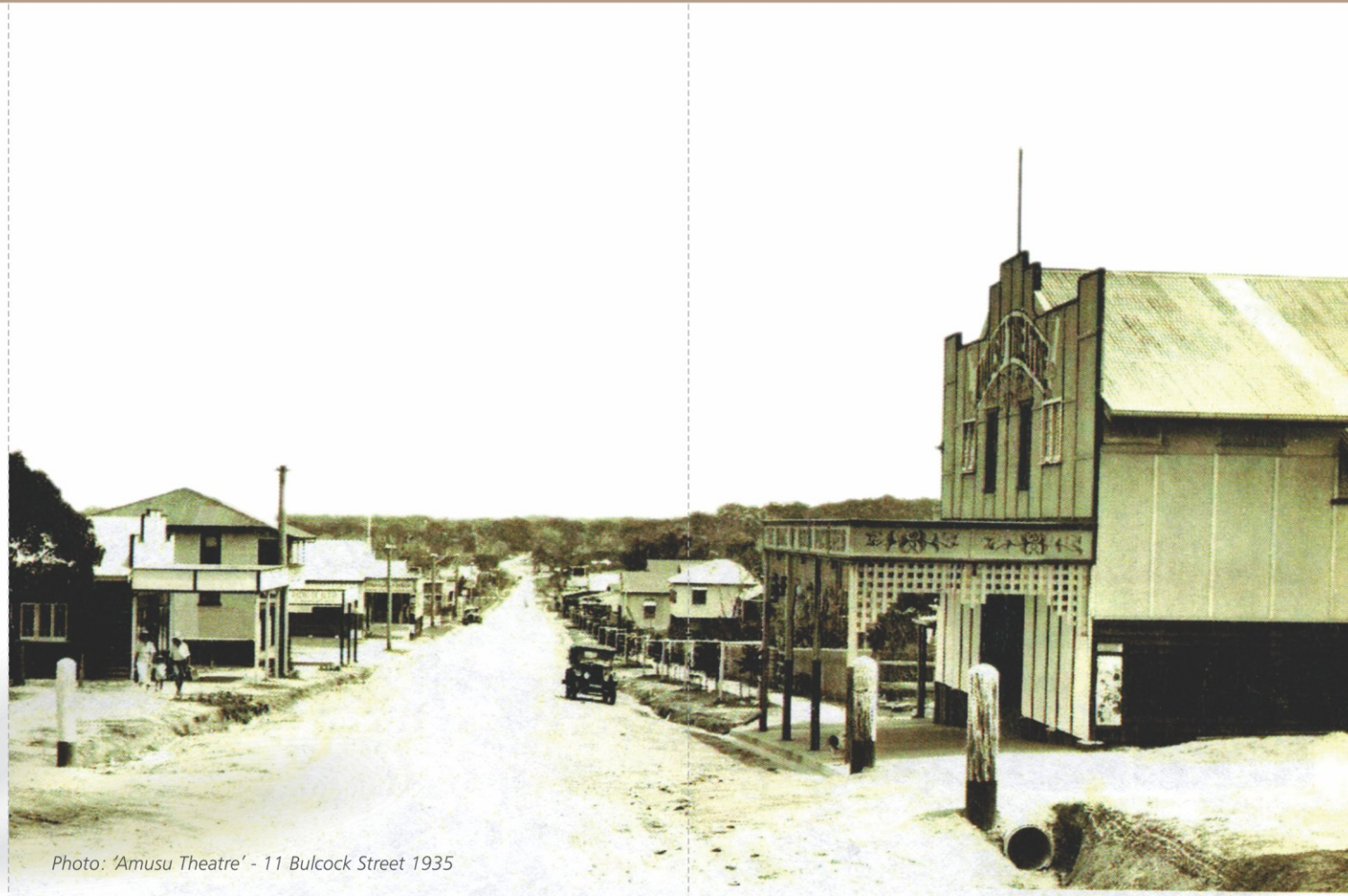


Photo: 'Amusu Theatre' - 11 Bulcock Street 1935
