CALOUNDRA ROAD  
ACCESS TO PROPOSED ROTARY PARK

I refer to your letter of 10th July, 1981.

This Department would not object to an access to the proposed park subject to the following conditions.

1. The access should be located as near as possible to the eastern boundary of the area.
2. The access should be constructed as per the attached drawing for Access (Type 1) as a minimum standard. The low standard of access will be acceptable as it is planned to widen Caloundra Road to four lanes within three years in conjunction with the Caloundra Bypass.
3. All work within the road reserve must be carried out by your Council.
4. It is assumed that, the access to the park will replace the existing access to the Australian

Dear Mr. Jensen,

I refer to your discussions with Mr. M. Poole, Council's Engineer in relation to the development of that part of Reserve 1000 fronting Caloundra Road, Caloundra.

The Council has agreed to the layout and will be prepared to clean and maintain the proposed toilet block and keep the area slashed when necessary.

An approach has been made to the Main Roads Department in relation to access to the park area and I shall advise you further in this regard when advice is to hand from that Department.

I am also to advise that Council has asked the Engineer to prepare an estimate of cost for connection of sewerage to the area so that Council can ascertain whether extension of the sewer in this vicinity would be warranted.
