1. Install 2 by 1 pedestal toilets and 3 water tanks, with guttering, at Sassamunga Hospital.

2. Install 2 by 2 pedestal toilets and 1 water tank, with guttering, and daisy-chain to existing tank at Sassamunga Secondary School.

3. Replace tsunami damaged tank stand for existing tank and replace tsunami damaged water pipes to kindergarten toilets, shower/wash room and lunch room at Bibolo. Make ablution rooms and lunch room secure by installing security mesh to 19 windows.
