CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR POSITION OF GOVERNOR OF ROTARY DISTRICT 9620 FOR 2021-2022 ROTARY YEAR

In accordance with the Rotary International By-Laws, nominations are called for suitably qualified Rotarians, to apply for the position of District Governor of Rotary District 9620 for the Rotary year 2021-2022.

On 1 July 2021 our three Districts will merge to become District 9620. In creating this new District, we have the opportunity to take advantage of the rapid changes taking place in society today. In a letter to all Rotarians on 31 August 2018, we detailed the processes that we would follow to create a new District, that would be relevant now and well into the future, to serve the needs of all our members.

As discussed in that letter we have created six Action Groups. Each of the six action groups has been working in their respective areas involving members across the three Districts in developing processes and procedures to ensure that there will be a seamless transition to the new District on 1 July 2021. One of the more urgent requirements to ensure we are ready, is the selection of the first District Governor for District 9620. This is important because the lead time to ensure that the District Governor is ready to take on the role, is two years. We also see that it is important for the selected candidate to be involved in the transition process as early as possible.

Qualifications of a District Governor

These are detailed in the Rotary International By-Laws 16.070, which require all applicants for the position of District Governor to be a member of good standing in a functioning club; that the applicant must have full qualifications of membership; that the applicant must have served as a president of a Rotary club for a full term; that the applicant can confirm her/his ability to fulfil the duties of Governor; and the applicant must demonstrate knowledge of the qualifications, duties and responsibilities of a District Governor as prescribed in the By-Laws. Past-District Governors who are current members of Rotary District 9600, or 9630 or 9640 are eligible to apply to be District Governor of Rotary District 9620.

Selection of District Governor

The District Governor will be selected by a Nominating Committee comprising:

a. The Immediate Past District Governor of District 9600 (selected by mutual agreement), who will be Chair of the Nominating Committee:





- b. The three current District Governors;
- The three current District Governors Elect; and
- d. Three Rotarians selected as explained below.

This process has been agreed by the majority of clubs in each of our current three Districts. Interviews will take place on **Saturday, 16th March 2019** at Bostock House, Wacol, Brisbane. This is an exciting opportunity for the successful Applicant to be the first District Governor for District 9620 and to lead our new District in the 2021-2022 Rotary Year.

Applications

Applications must be submitted on the Governor-nominee Form attached. The nomination must be supported by the Applicant's Rotary Club and be endorsed accordingly by the Club Secretary. Applications should be accompanied by a brief Bio including a statement as to why you want to serve as District Governor. Further, as this will be a new Rotary District, the nominating committee will also be seeking information about the vision that the applicant has for this new Rotary District. We recommend that all applicants seek further advice on the Transition Process from their current District Governor, or the Chair of the nominating committee, IPDG John W Lane.
