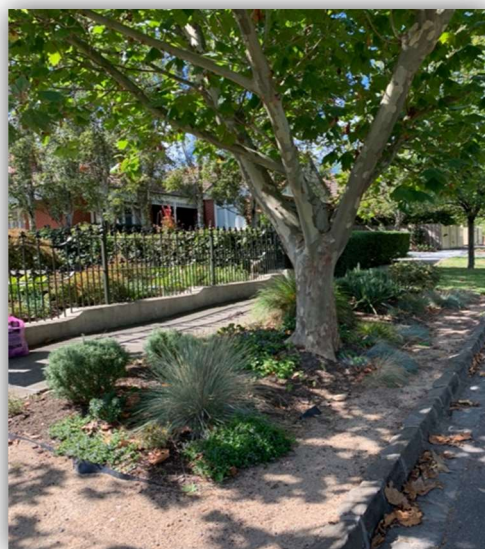
Transforming your nature strip can be as easy as:
