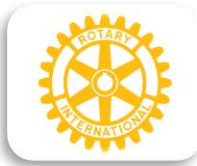


Hands On International Volunteer Trip 2020



Woodland and Tri County (VMBN) Rotary Club invite you to participate in the International Volunteer Trips (IVT) Caguas Puerto Rico from March 18 to 22-2020.

1. Volunteers will unify efforts with local leaders and families of Caguas, Puerto Rico to implement the **Access Safe Drinking Water Program.**

- Every month Woodland welcomes volunteers such as Family Physicians, Nurses, Dentist, Lab Technicians, Med Students, Audiologist, Engineers, Teachers, Social Workers, Corporate teams, Rotary Clubs, Rotaract, Interact, High Schools and Non- Medical volunteers.

2. Duration and cost of the trip:

- Each team needs a minimum of 5 individuals registered.
- The cost for March 18 to 22 days (1 week) is \$675 per person. (includes in-country expenses: meals, lodging, ground transportation, translators, program administration expenses and evacuation insurance) Bi-lingual volunteers are encouraged to participate. This cost do not include airplane ticket.
- Volunteers are responsible for purchasing their own roundtrip airplane ticket from the U.S. to Puerto Rico. *

***Please do not purchase your airplane ticket until approved by team coordinator.**

3. Trip activities include:

- Installing water filters, sanitation-clean up, minor home repairs
- Volunteer work at the community farm/garden
- Sewing machine training, English/computer classes and other activities at the school or in the community.

Submit registration 4 weeks before the trip date with a \$200 none refundable deposit.
