Objective

'To provide an opportunity to Taiwan students to develop leadership, presentation and communication skills through pitching a project identifying and addressing a social need in their community which can be realized within one year'

Time Restriction / Rating Table

The presentations for the semifinals and final rounds are live

- Time limit for these presentations are minimum 7 minutes and maximum 10 minutes.
- The Head Judge keeps time. For each minute under- or overtime 3 points are deducted from the total score.
- Rating table: 1 – missed or poor, 2 – insufficient, 3 – adequate, 4 – good, 5 - excellent

Judging Criteria

Concept / Feasibility

40% of total score.

- Issue clear and concise - *what*
- Community relevant to ESSC – *where* and *who*
- Distinct objective - how is success measured?
- Strategy to reach goal - feasible, innovative, effective

Judging Criteria

Execution

40% total score

- Actionable – realistic plan which can be realized by presenter or presenting team
- Execution plan adequately addresses issue presented in introduction
- Necessary resources identified – including funding
- Project management – timeline, milestones, deliverables

Judging Criteria

Presentation

20% total score

- Speech has an introduction, body and conclusion. Introduction includes a self-introduction Clear vocal communication in English (grammar and correct pronunciation not rated)
- Physical presentation - appearance, body language. Quality of video or slides - entertaining and meet the criteria set for these.
