• Time limit for video presentations: minimum 5 minutes, maximum 7 minutes.

- Time limit for these presentations are minimum 7 minutes and maximum 10 minutes.
- The Head Judge keeps time. For each minute under- or overtime 3 points are deducted from de total score.
- Rating table: 1 missed or poor, 2 insufficient, 3 adequate, 4 good, 5 - excellent

- Project management timeline, milestones, deliverables

#### 20% total score

- Speech has an introduction, body and conclusion. Introduction includes a self-introduction Clear vocal communication in English (grammar and correct pronunciation not rated)
- Physical presentation appearance, body language. Quality of video or slides entertaining and meet the criteria set for these.
