



2019 Rotary Club of Hampton Roads \$5,000 REVERSE RAFFLE OFFICIAL RULES

- Unlike a typical raffle, in this Reverse Raffle, the purchaser of the last ticket drawn wins the grand prize as detailed herein.
- Grand Prize: up to \$5,000 will be awarded on Saturday, April 6, 2019 at the Military Aviation Museum in Virginia Beach, VA. A minimum of 200 tickets must be sold for the \$5,000 to be awarded. If fewer than 200 tickets are sold, the Grand Prize will be 40% of the Net Proceeds as detailed herein. The minimum prize amount shall be \$1,000.
- Net Proceeds is defined as the total number of tickets sold at \$35.00 per ticket.
- A maximum of 500 tickets will be sold.
- The event begins at 5:30 p.m. The event is open to the public for the price of admission.
- Standard ticket cost is \$100.00 each. The ticket price includes entry to the event for one person and one entry for the Grand Prize raffle.
- You must be 18 years or older to purchase a raffle ticket.
- A raffle ticket must be purchased. A ticket is considered purchased when complete payment (\$100.00 for standard ticket) has been received and recorded by the event chairperson or a Rotary Club of Hampton Roads's representative. Complimentary admission to the event does not include a raffle ticket.
- Ticket sales will stop no later than Saturday, April 6, 2019 at 5:30 p.m., unless all tickets have been sold prior to that time.
- Interval drawings may be held throughout the event. Interval drawing winners may receive an experience, item, or a gift card of varying price values.
- If a minimum of 200 tickets are sold, anywhere from five to ten ticket holders will be drawn and will be asked to come forward.
- The five to ten ticket holders will have the opportunity to decide whether to continue with the raffle or split the Grand Prize.
- If the selected ticket holders agree to stop and split the Grand Prize, the Grand Prize will be divided between the selected ticket holders.
- However, if at least one selected ticket holder does not agree to split the Grand Prize, the raffle will continue and a ticket of the selected ticket holders will be drawn, which will eliminate that selected ticket holder.
- The deliberation to either agree or move forward with the reverse raffle will continue until either the remaining selected ticket holders agree to split the Grand Prize or there is only one selected ticket holder that has not been eliminated and that selected ticket holder will win the Grand Prize solely.
- Winner of the Grand Prize need not be present to win. If a selected ticket holder is not present, the reverse raffle will continue with no option to split the Grand Prize.
- One person must be named as the Ticket Owner per ticket. The Ticket Owner controls the ticket and, if
 present, is responsible for making the decision to split the Grand Prize with the other selected ticket
 holders.
- Prizes will be awarded to the Ticket Owner only.
- Winners are solely responsible for any and all taxes due on their winnings.
