John F. (Jeff) Tanner Jr., Ph.D. is Dean of Strome College of Business, Old Dominion University, in Norfolk, Virginia. He joined the Strome College in 2015; since then he has nearly doubled the College's endowment and led the creation of new programs to attract, retain, and graduate high achieving students. Under his leadership, Constant Hall is undergoing a transformation with the development of innovative learning spaces such as the George Jensen Communications Lab, the ADP Human Capital Management Lab, and Southern Bank Synergy Spaces. Combined with the new Dick Thurmond Negotiations Research Lab, and a field laboratory that empowers women through the development of stronger negotiation and communications skills.



Dean Tanner is author or co-author of 15 books; including: Building Partnerships (co-authored with Steve Castleberry) which will be published in 2021. As a leading scholar and expert in customer strategy, Dr. Tanner has published 80-plus journal articles. He completed a term as editor of Marketing Education Review. As a serial entrepreneur, Dr. Tanner has partnered to start successful businesses in data management, information technology, professional services, and real estate. He regularly teaches executives around the world and is a frequent speaker at global conferences.

Dr. Tanner is also host of NPR's Strome Business Minute, a radio program heard daily on WHRV and one of the top downloaded podcasts in the region. He has appeared regularly on various radio and internet radio and video programs. Locally, he was listed on Inside Business' Power List for three of the last four years. Dr. Tanner currently serves on the Executive Committee of the Hampton Roads Chamber of Commerce and the Board of Directors of Versability, as well as the vestry of Christ & St. Luke's, serving two years as senior warden. He and his wife, Karen, breed and race thoroughbred horses, including retired stakes winner No Llores Catita, and two 2-year-olds getting ready for the track, Karen's Catita, and Queenie Pennie.
