Last week we reviewed global grants. This week is district grants. District Grants fund small-scale, short-term activities that address needs in your community and communities abroad. Each district chooses activities it will fund with these grants. What they support-Humanitarian projects, scholarships, youth programs, and vocational training teams. Recipients may customize projects.

Funding-Districts may use up to 50 percent of their District Designated Fund to receive one district grant. They get funding in one lump sum.

Qualifications- Districts need to become qualified to apply for grants. Fund distribution-Clubs apply directly to district. Individual districts administer their own grants.
