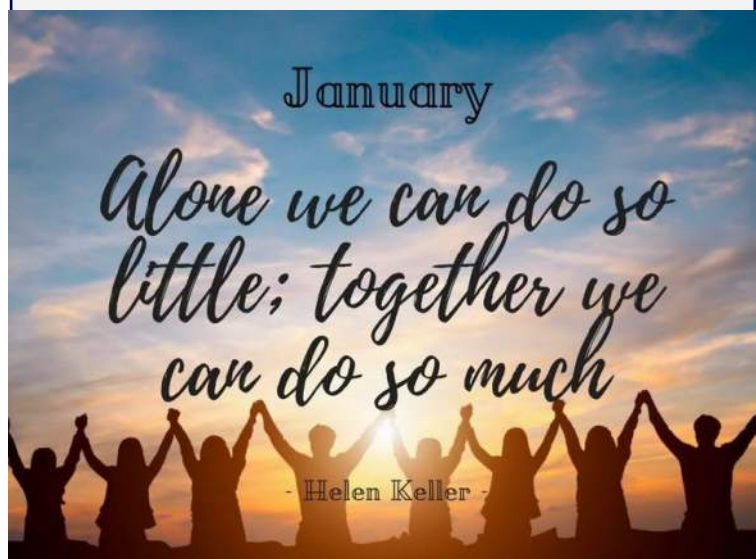

CHARLIE'S ROTARY MOMENT

Rotary Global Grants- This program replaced Ambassadorial Scholarships in 2013. This program expands on the Ambassadorial mission, by ensuring that every Rotarian Scholar advance Rotary's International goodwill, and peace. The scholarship funds graduate level coursework or research for one to four academic years. Any approved University located in a country where the host Rotary Club or District, outside of the applicant's home country. Graduate -level course or research in one of Rotary's six areas of focus: Peace and conflict prevention/resolution, Disease prevention, Water Treatment, and Sanitation, Maternal and childcare health, Basic education and Literacy, and Economic and Community Development. Target groups are non-Rotarians sponsored by Rotary Districts or clubs. The minimum budget for a global scholarship is \$30,000, which will fund various things. Our club has sponsored some very talented and exciting non-Rotarians in past years.



ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Shawn Avery is President and CEO of the Hampton Roads Workforce Council. Shawn has Business Administration Degrees (BS and MS) from Christopher Newport University and Florida Institute of Technology.



As the president of the Hampton Roads Workforce Council, Avery has made strides in rebranding the jobs placement organization that serves as an economic development tool with a more relevant name and collaboration with the Greater Peninsula Workforce Development Board.
