District 9650 Conference Report

Assoc.Prof. DR Ray Hodgson spoke on the new hospital to be built in Nepal. At this stage they are only under \$100,000 short of the \$1.5 million build cost, they have secured a Global Grant from Rotary for \$450,000 to equip the wards.

They have already started to train staff and as soon as Covid allows building will commence.

Sadly much of Nepal was devastated by ajor earthquakes and the situation is very grim at present.

District 9650 Conference Report

President Peter and Sue and Trish Smyth attended the Conference last weekend. Key Note Speaker Shane Fitzsimmons, Commissioner of Resilience NSW was a standout speaker.

He spoke about the bushfires. The build up to the 2019 fires was the hottest and driest on record. The 2019 bushfires did not just suddenly come out of nowhere; there had been a 1000 fires a month, prior to the major outbreaks. 100% of the State had been drought declared. Shane talked about the Port Macquarie swamp fire which burned for over 200 days. Shane reflected on volunteers as the underpinning of the State and on the 75,000 volunteers and workforce who comprise the fire fighting and emergency services. He talked about leadership in a crisis and his approach to it : be open and honest; let people know what you are doing, why you are not doing some things, what do you want others to hear?

He also said "Leaders need to care : about their role, their team, their colleagues, their supervisors".

He also made a plea for men to share their thoughts and feelings, talk to their families and mates. This was particularly relevant as we go in to having the Men's Health Van. And as a good finishing up he talked about the lessons children said they had learnt from the Bushfires and it came down to : I am not alone You are not alone We are not alone
