

Darren started his working life as a panel beater to help out his family when his dad had a heart attack and couldn't work.

After a serious injury at work Darren retrained in social science and joined the Smith Family eleven years ago.

The Smith Family started in 1922 when a group of businessmen gave Christmas presents to children from impoverished families.

Wanting to remain anonymous, they chose to be known as the Smith Family. In the 1990s the organisation changed its focus to improving educational outcomes for vulnerable children. They do this through reading buddies and homework clubs which are supported by donors. Volunteers are recruited and a new homework club is starting in Toormina in Term 2 this year.


