Fast Auf Wiedersehen (nearly goodbye)


The club was delighted to be joined by Emily Buckle and her family for Emily's presentation as an outgoing exchange student in 2020.

As this was our final meeting of the year, President Warren Hollyman wished every present a safe and happy festive season and all the best for the New Year.



Sawtell Rotarians provided their expert BBQing skills for the launch of the free summer Plan B Bus. From the early hours of Tuesday 3rd of December Shane Della, Alison Williams, Phil Makinson, Ellis Nicholson, Alan Freedman and Warren Hollyman served egg & bacon rolls and sausage sandwiches at the Jetty Foreshore.

The message from Transport NSW:

RBT means you need a Plan B – if you're going out for a few drinks this festive season, make sure that you have a safe way to get home that doesn't involve getting behind the wheel. If you're drinking, don't drive.

A 'Plan B' bus will operate in and around Coffs Harbour on Friday and Saturday nights during December 2019 and January 2020, including New Year's Eve. During the trial, the bus will travel each of three routes once per night, with pick-up and drop-off at any stop on the routes.

The bus will have a security guard on board.


