Remember November is Foundation Month.

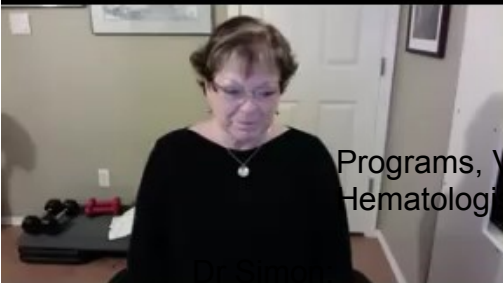

Programs, Vancouver Island University, Dr. Puneet, is an Oncologist / Hematologist specialist at the North Vancouver Hospital.

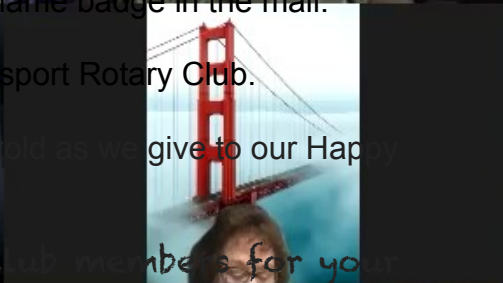
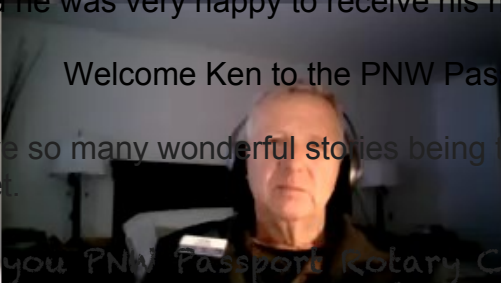
