Location: Anuban Hua Hin Nongkhon School Technology Enhanced Learning for Knowledge (TELK) Classroom.

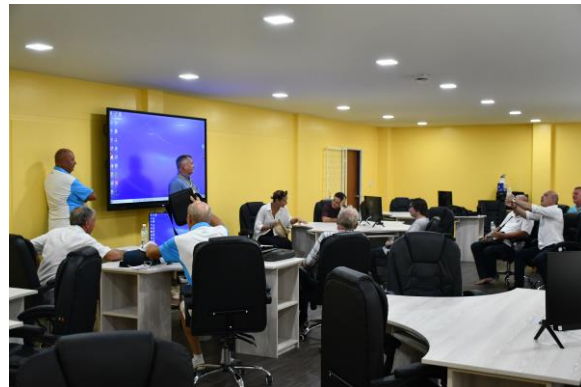

President (P) Brian Anderson opened the meeting by welcoming the members and guests to the TELK Classroom and called upon Sergeant at Arms (SAA) Rick Rees to introduce the guests as listed above.

P Brian then spoke about the following club events that had recently occurred.

4<sup>th</sup> August Fellowship Evening Monsoon Valley wine bar

P Brian called upon PE/Sec Phil Lawrence to TALK about the TELK Project.

PE/Sec Phil welcomed the members and guests to the TELK classroom and went onto say the relationship with the Anuban Nongkhon School has been a long and fruitful one, and with the aging school facilities becoming untenable for modern teaching practices the school wanted to build a new purpose-built school building of 15 classrooms and came to the RCRHH to help support this project. Discussions on this project started back in 2018 and has taken two years to reach fruition as the new school building was completed in May 2020.

As part of the contribution by the RCRHH the school Director promised that the club would receive one classroom to be used by the club to develop enhanced learning for children and thus was borne the dream of establishing a Rotary Education Center at the school to teach students advanced lessons in English, Sciences, and the arts.

Rotarian Dr Keith Humphreys through his work with establishing education centers in Hong Kong and the Thai Voices project at the Phetchaburi Panyanukul school proposed that we take the project further and establish one of the first Technology Enhanced Learning for Knowledge (TELK) in Thailand, and thus planning for this project started in early 2019.

Following the signing of a memorandum of understanding between the school and the RCRHH in 2019 the school promised to add an additional classroom, therefore giving us a double sized room that you are now sitting in.



The overall cost of establishing the TELK will be 2.7 million Thai Baht with over 1.7 million already pledged, the remaining money will be raised through private donors, other RC and grants.

This is by far one of the most ambitious projects the RCRHH has ever embarked on and offers to establish the club as providing a state-of-the-art Education facility here in Hua Hin that will leave a lasting legacy for the club. I personally feel the money has been well spent, this room has the wow factor.

PE/Sec Phil then explained what the money had been spent on:

So far, the Rotary Club of Royal Hua Hin have invested over 2,86 Million Thai Baht in the Anuban Hua Hin Nongkhon including a donation of 1 Million Thai Baht towards the new School Building. Phases 1-3 of the project are listed below.
