P Brian then called upon todays guest speaker Secretary, President Elect Phil Lawrence to talk about Fire Safety in the Home. P Brian introduced Phil in his customary way through a number of pictures fortunately he did not discover some of the dodgier photos. The one on the left dates back to late 1970's when he was a young fire fighter and had hair including a typical risqué moustache, and had not discovered vitamin Chang.

Phil started the session with a video showing the guests the potential impact fires can have even on the experts.

Phil then explained that to understand the hazards posed by fire people had

to understand a little of fire theory and they were introduced to the fire triangle where three components of oxygen, heat and a fuel in the correct proportions are required for fire to occur.

Members and guests where then asked what hazards did, they feel were present in their homes that may cause or help develop a fire situation. This brought an array of interesting answers which were explored further

Phil then showed another video of the fire growth in the room and ways by good practice and routine to help minimise or prevent the risk of fires in their home. The speed from which the initial ignition to a fully developed fire in a room in under 5 minutes surprised some of the members and guests.

Lastly Phil looked at some statistics of fires and fire related deaths in the UK and the USA yet research showed no government records here in Thailand.

Some interesting questions were raised from the floor. P Brian declared no other business, lunch was called.
