Rtn Benjamas Uamsa-Ard explained that the Stamford International University Rotaractors together with 22 Chinese Students will be conducting a beach clean on Thursday 16 Aug 18, starting at Khao Takieb beach at 1400h. Rotarians are invited to join them.

Napa Keawtem explained that on 23-24 Aug 18 RCRHH will be working with RCHH when the Thoracic Society of Thailand would be conducting public screenings for tuberculosis at two hospitals in Hua Hin. We have been invited to help prepare and serve food at Hospital No 3 to feed medical staff and attendees. Over 500 people are expected to attend and those found to be suffering with a lung infection will be taken to Bangkok Hospital for treatment. P Brian urged support as this is a really powerful way to engage with the community and show support for those less privileged.

Alan Brown spoke about the Golf Tournament and the importance of visibility as it is the major fund raiser. He said the committee had changed from last year and asked members to see if they could find support or sponsorship from friends and contacts in the local community.

P Brian explained that he, IPP Birger, PE Napa, Sec Martin and Rtn Benjamas had attended the SIU to talk to Rotaractors about the benefits of Rotary last Thursday 8 Aug. The full story is on CR News.

The President then introduced Martin Harrison & Peter Wydler who gave a presentation on the Club's new web site, Club Runner. The presentation was designed to assist members using the site in a simple and effective way. The idea being that members would only need to use the Home Page for any information they needed. The site is constantly evolving and members were advised to check it a least twice a week.

Martin ran through logging on, changing password, registering for events and registering by e mail, using the toolbar, meeting notes and minutes, checking stories and use of the calendar, general matters, Club Runner mobile app, and non-members access.

Club Runner is not only the public face of RCRHH but is also now its management tool, doing away with the need for paper records. Some members took advantage of the workshop after the presentation where lap tops were networked and passwords and usernames re-set.
