Patrick Franssen asked the question whether we could go back to using an SMS when notifying members of events as was used previously before club runner.

Martin replied that he does not think there is the facility for SMS as well as e-mail, but the e mail is necessary to provide the link to register. Maybe we should advertise the phone app as a compromise.

Martin went on to explain that the phone app is only a 'lite' version of CR.

Paul Grab raised the question that why did the mobile number not work on the phone app on club runner?

Martin explained that all nubers had been checked and adjusted and this would now work. However there would be a cost implication if you used this app.

Helmut Schepers raised the point that when he registers guests on club runner, if he registers the same guest for another event the persons details are not captured and the details have to be put in again.

Martin replied unfortunately this is a drawback with the system but the club runner committee were working to help solve this problem.

Peter Wydler and Peter Iversen talked to the meeting about using google calender with current smart phones as this can be linked to club runner and shows members all the events as shown on club runner.

Both Peters gave a tutorial on how to download both the club runner app and how to access the google calender on their smart phones.

Members were given private tuition on how to do the above for those that required help.

P Brian thanked Martin, Peter and Peter on the work they have done on club runner over the last year and stated that overall club runeer is a great tool that has improved communication with members over the last 12 months.
