E-JAN – Sompratana Nawong – Guest Speaker



E-Jan's objectives are mainly help people in need all over Thailand. It's structure consists of 50 employees utilizing 16 million followers on social media, of which 12.6 million are on Facebook with the balance coming from Insta-gram, Twitter, YouTube and others.

Khun Sompratana began the presentation by describing that the current conditions at the Anuban Nongkon school in Hua Hin for special needs children are unacceptable. There are currently 50 children having 9 different disabilities in one 48 sq. meter room.

E-Jan has made contacts with several high-profile people and entities to get the project started. To date it has raised 10 million baht of which 1.2 million baht was raised through T-Shirt sales alone. Land consisting of 3 rai has been given by the Ministry of Education which is located near Black Mountain. The total budget for building the school is 16 – 20 million baht.

The school will consist of 8 main classrooms designed to support a special needs curriculum, along with disability bathrooms, canteen, kitchen, and a teacher's room. Construction is scheduled to start in June 2022 and is to be completed in 7 months. An additional 3 months

will be needed to furnish the school. Once complete, the government will fund the on-going costs and school expenses.

E-Jan is asking RCRHH to help fund the construction of a "Sensory Room". Construction cost for the room is 800K Baht and for the room technology and furniture it's 200K Baht. Total 1 million Baht. PP Napa Keawtem will contact E-Jan by May 25th to inform them that there is a definite commitment to fund 500K Baht next year towards room construction, technology, and furniture.









At E-Jan's request, RCRHH has obtained booth space at the upcoming DTA next month in Cha-Am for selling T-Shirts and other goods to raise funding for this project. The actual designs on the T-Shirts were done by the special needs students who will be part of the project.
