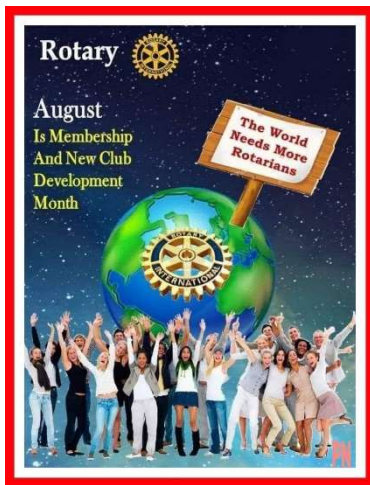
Phil welcomed all attendees and guests to our weekly meeting.



P Phil introduced our rotary District 3330, area 16 Assistant Governor Rampai Kamwijan from the RC Prachuab Khiri Khan.

P Phil went onto say that the Month of August is the month of Rotary membership, and mentioned that the theme is one member brings a new member. P Phil reiterated that the club's membership is the backbone of the club, and that new members as well as older members should be encouraged to participate more in club activities and become part of the future of our club.

Our club has a fantastic history, however that history cannot hold back on the future development of our club.



P Phil went onto mention that Jennifer Jones began her term as Rotary International's 2022-23 president in the midst of her Imagine Rotary Canada Tour, traveling coast to coast to coast to draw attention to the positive and lasting impact that Rotary clubs have in their communities.

Organized around several hubs, the tour started on 17 June with an excursion through Yukon and the Northwest Territories, brushing up against the Beaufort Sea, an arm of the Arctic Ocean and one of Canada's three coasts. From there, it visited Jones' home city of Windsor, Ontario, and then the nation's capital, Ottawa. It next moved to St. John's on the Atlantic Ocean before heading west through Quebec City, Toronto, Winnipeg, Calgary, Ed

P Phil then mentioned that although many of our Rotarians are not always in Thailand that does not mean they do not continue to support our club.

Rotarian Ingrid Eckert -Prinz is currently living in the Cote de Azur and has visited some of the clubs in the area to promote the Rotary Club of Royal Hua Hin and what we do. On Tuesday 2nd August Ingrid visited the RC Cote De Nice one of the four clubs in the region and exchanged banners with the club.



Our Sergeant At Arms David Range and his wife Shuba were visiting family in Delhi when David experienced back problems. On a recommendation he visited the Dukh Niwaran Samti Charitable Hospital in Vasant Vihar Delhi. During his treatment he found out that one of the heat therapy machines was broken thus reducing the hospitals' ability to treat patients. David generously sourced and purchased a new heat therapy machine for the hospital.



Once again the RCRHH Supported the Nong Hoi School, this time purchasing training equipment, and trophies for the schools 7 a side football tournament. Teams from three age groups under 16's, under 12's and under 10's. PP Brian presented the trophies to the successful teams in each age group.

The fellowship evening for August was held at the Phoenix 51 on Soi 51 (Party Street). 23 members and guests enjoyed free flow wine and beer, Thai and western food.



Rotary District 3330 held it's Vibrant Club Workshop on the 6th August at the Medi Hotel in Nakhon Pathom. President Elect Helmut Schepers, Treasurer Albert Labermeier, Membership Chair Torsten Voigt, and President Phil Lawrence attended three workshops on Membership, Foundation and Public Image.





On the 23rd July the RCRHH held it's first Installation dinner for three years. The club not only installed President Phil Lawrence and Rotaractor Presidents Khun Asia from Stamford International University and Khun Sirima from Rajamangala University Wangklaikangwon Campus.

In addition, we celebrated the Presidential years of Napa Keawtem Rotary year 115, Brain Anderson 116 and Phil Lawrence 117. P Phil spoke about the exciting new project that will be launched at the Anuban Hua Hin Nongkhon School Rotary Education Center in partnership with the Rotary Club of Thavaravadi Free English on Line Program.

This will, be the sixth year the club have run this successful program and aims to teach a 1-year program of English learning with 32 teachers at the above school.



P Phil introduced today's guest speaker Jos Muijtjens from the Thai Ayutthaya Business Administration Technological College (TAB). Phil went on to say that Jos has two passions in life: one is his music and his big band B2F who hope to start playing later this year, and his job of teaching students.



Jos stated that the TAB was founded in the year 1997 by Dr. Chatchai Pukayaporn whose father Dr. Suk Pukayaporn founded the Striatum University. TAB is a college of the Thai-Tech group which has 10 affiliated colleges/schools located in the Bangkok perimeter and the surrounding provinces and focuses on the following vocational training courses:

- Accounting
- Business Computer
- Marketing
- Tourism (IHAT)
- Game and Animations



Jos went on to talk about the international project with the Mercuria college in Finland which would see an exchange between 6 students from Finland come to Thailand and 6 students from Thailand go to Finland.

However, two of the students' families were unable to meet the cost of the air fares to Finland, so through Jos' connections with Rotarian Lizzy Ginsel, the Rotary Club of Royal Hua Hin were able to sponsor 20,000 Thai Baht to go towards the cost of the flights.

Jos then played some recordings of the students who travelled to Porvoo who talked about their visit and what they like about Finland. More importantly, before they travelled they did not speak English, now being part of the exchange program and visiting Finland they felt more confident in their abilities with speaking English.

Jos went on to talk about the next challenges of the Erasmus and KA2 project 2022/23, see slide below.



Jos answered a number of questions from the attendees. P Phil thanked Jos, and stated this project was a fantastic opportunity to help develop young Thai people, that give them enhanced opportunities in the workplace that would benefit not only themselves, their families and the wider community.
