



Geoff's Health Tips Salmonella poisoning is increasing Worldwide

Illnesses from <u>Salmonella poisoning</u> have been in the <u>news lately</u>. In Victoria, a Salmonella outbreak resulted in 62 people being infected though consumption of 'wash and toss pre-packed lettuce'. In Queensland there were 1,895 cases reported in 2015, half of which were from the Salmonella strain linked to egg and chicken products. In South Australia, 1,210 cases were reported over the same period.



An infectious diseases expert at the Australian National University reported that Salmonella infections were increasing every year in Australia with more than 10,000 cases reported and in the USA there are over 1 million cases being reported annually.

Salmonella is found on food surfaces everywhere and there is no point trying to eradicate it. What is apparent is that it is associated more with some foods than with others.


What is Salmonella? Salmonella is a bacterium which can cause food poisoning and less commonly, infection in the bloodstream and other organs. Most people infected with Salmonella suffer stomach pain, headache, diarrhoea, nausea and fever that can last for at least a week.

Salmonella is more commonly found on the surfaces of meat, especially poultry, as well as on eggs and foods prepared with raw eggs. Even when chicken is washed after slaughter, tests show that about a quarter of all cut-up chicken tests positive to Salmonella. In the case of the infected lettuce, it could have originated in immature animal manure fertiliser used around the plants, and then insufficient washing of the leaves before packaging.

To avoid Salmonella poisoning, graduates of the food handlers course will be aware that thorough hand washing is essential and that meat must be thoroughly cooked. Adequate cooking destroys Salmonella. Lettuce and other leafy greens should always be washed and dried prior to consumption. Cracked eggs should be rejected and dirty eggs cleaned and then cooked thoroughly.


