North East Community Hub Project Planning for a new Community Hub in Balwyn North.



Water filters arrive in Minh Hac, arranged by Rotary North Balwyn and part funded by a Rotary Foundation grant. Units have been supplied to the kindergarten, primary school, secondary school, health clinic, Community centre and People's Committee meeting room.

A study funded by an association of engineers in Melbourne and interpreted by the Vietnam Institute of Industrial Chemistry formed the basis of the project. Until now, parents of the students or orphan students have had to fund the supply of large water bottles.

International Director Imre Lele and President Rowan McClean will inspect installations next month accompanied by Friends Of Rotary Rachael Nguyen and Dr. Max Hardie and sponsors Paul and Jane Dillon.



Work on the new community centre in North Balwyn, the North East Hub, has commenced with the demolishing of the RSL and kindergarten buildings.

On March 6<sup>th</sup> sod turning ceremony was conducted with dignitaries in attendance including Hon Josh Frydenberg, Boroondara Mayor Phillip Healey and Boroondara Citizens of the year Graham and Gwenda Foard.

Graham was a founding member of the North Balwyn Rotary Club in1980. Graham and Gwenda have been recognised as 2017 Boroondara Citizens of the year due to their heavy involvement in the transition of the RSL site into the Community Centre.
