The winners this year will be RAWA indigenous community school in remote WA and Wheelchairs for Kids. Both great beneficiaries!



Members must book soon as numbers must be finalised by the end of December.


The Johnson Collection a collection of art works from Mr. William Johnson (1911-1986) who was an art dealer who left his house and collection as a museum for the public to enjoy.
