#### **Meeting Report**

#### Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> November – Speaker, Detective Senior Sergeant Paul Scarlett

Our Speaker last week presented a "roller coaster" speech of horrifying murder scene descriptions through to hilarious stories of heists gone funnily wrong and back to the seriousness of mental health issues throughout our community.

Detective Senior Sergeant Paul Scarlett was accompanied by his wife, Rania, herself a Bravery Award recipient from the Prime Minister in recognition of her efforts during the 1996 Port Arthur massacre.



Chairman, Geoff Kneale, introduced Paul by describing his tireless work over 3 decades in numerous Squads including the Rape, Drug, Major Fraud, Homicide and various other divisions.

Currently a witness in yet another murder trial of serial murderer, Peter Dupas, Paul has investigated Dupas for 17 years and was instrumental in the release from prison of lawyer Andrew Fraser who, in turn, provided the damning evidence of Dupas'third murder that led his third life sentence.

Paul's speech turned to detailing the structural, training and technical advancements in policing during his career. Mental health support within the force and managing those law breakers suffering from mental health issues; SOG/ SAS training at Chadstone shopping centre simulating a mass shooting scenario; new police equipment including high powered weapons and passive restraint equipment; the advancements and cold case benefits of Trace DNA.

Those 53 Rotarians and visitors in attendance on Thursday evening will clearly remember the funny side of the 7 Eleven armed robbery that ended where it started with the robber taking flight on the 302 bus – only to be delivered back to the 7 Eleven and arresting officers since the 302 bus route actually terminated at that same 7 Eleven.

Paul also vividly described the Bonnie and Clyde armed robbery at The Cuckoo restaurant in the Dandenongs when "Clyde" shot "Bonnie" in her derriere. On arresting "Clyde" and reading him his rights, Paul whispered in "Clyde's" ear, "well mate, you made a half-arsed effort that robbery!"

The same could not be said for Paul's terrific presentation.

#### Geoff's Health Tips

#### Cocoa – the Real Heart of Chocolate

Unsweetened cocoa is the raw material for making chocolate – we all knew that – right? In case you were unsure, cocoa is the starting point to which you add sugar. To make dark chocolate you need at least 70% cocoa powder and a maximum 30% sugar.

There have been many studies showing that chocolate, especially dark chocolate, is good for your heart. It is now well established that dark chocolate is good for reducing arterial stiffness and for LDL cholesterol reduction, all factors in improving heart health.

- \* Flavonols are the primary ingredients in chocolate that are credited with this improvement in the cardiovascular system.
- \* Flavonols also lead to improvement in cognitive function, increasing processing ability and memory.
- \* We also know that cocoa has more antioxidant value than green tea or red wine. Antioxidants are important because they quell highly unstable free radicals.

It's important to remember that the flavonols and antioxidants are highly concentrated in cocoa and we should try to maximise its use.

I am sure you will find many recipes such as cocoa with fruit and nuts in a muesli mix and of course brownies and chocolate

course brownies and chocolate cake are always popular.

We all like our coffee, but why not try hot chocolate? You might like it and maybe it's healthier!
