From John Burley

Most of you would know that the northern half of Vanuatu has been devastated by Tropical Cyclone Harold last month. The damage is still being assessed but in some of the most populous areas 100% of houses have been damaged and a large proportion of these destroyed completely. Food crops have been wiped out and emergency relief supplies are only now reaching the most remote areas, as transport is very difficult when there are no wharves for landing boats and the basic tracks have been blocked by debris.

Many people have been injured and the most serious of these are slowly being moved to Port Vila Central Hospital for treatment. Due to the devastation, patients arrive at the hospital with only the clothes on their backs. Care that can be provided by the hospital is very basic - most patients rely on relatives for food etc. but they cannot reach Pt Vila at present.

*The Rotary Club of Port Vila has started a project to provide each of these patients with a **basic care pack** including clothing, hygiene items, food and eating utensils, none of which would otherwise be available. A complete list is attached.*

Each pack costs just over Aus\$77 and is being put together with the help of Rotarians and one of the Port Vila churches.

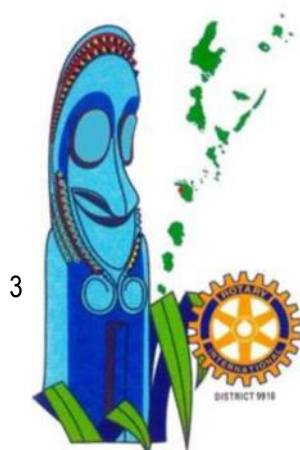

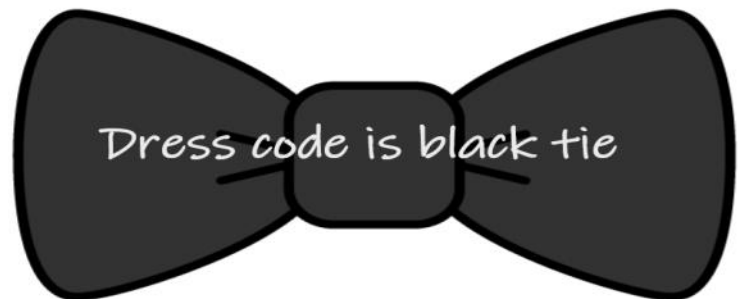

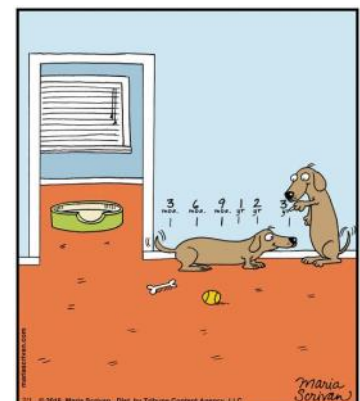

Some food markets are opening this week-end, however the Camberwell Sunday Market is quite different to the Saturday food market and will require several restrictions in place before reopening. Currently we are waiting to see what stage 3 revised restrictions bring before deciding how to re-open the Market in a limited way.

In the meantime the manager of the Market is in touch with an address list of more than 20,000 stall holders since the Market closed in March. I imagine there will be adequate notice of the reopening in order to have our roster organised.

A memo from your Foundation Director Findley Cornell

Due to the Covid 19 pandemic our club has suffered a severe reduction in our fundraising.

As a result, all your directors have had to cut back on their spending. .

The Foundation was no exception and our club's contribution to the Foundation was reduced to \$5000, approximately one third of our usual yearly amount.

Again due to Covid 19 we have had about 10 less "in person" meetings, a personal weekly saving of \$34 in meal costs, a saving of approximately \$340. Many of us have "paid" some of this into the voluntary service fund.

About half of our members donate personally to the Foundation through the "Every Rotarian Every Year" (EREY) program. Those who don't currently take part may wish to take this opportunity to contribute.

Think about this, a contribution of:-

One meeting, \$34, makes you an EREY (Rotary Australia definition)

Three meetings \$102 makes you a centurion (\geq \$100 RA definition)

USD 100, about AUD 150 makes you a sustaining member of the Foundation (RI definition) which roughly equates to 4 meetings and some beer, wine or spirits.
