MEETING REPORT

At our meeting Major Sponsors from the Golf Day and Grand Prix joined Members and Guests in hearing from renowned Australian public mental health researcher Dr Laura Hart.

Mental illness can affect every aspect of our lives. The number of school students suffering from diagnosable mental illness is profound and not enough young people seek help. Some 35% try and deal with it on their



own and don't even talk confidentially with their local GP.

Rotary

Mental Health First Aid, an Australian program now seen in 25 countries and growing, including USA, Canada and England, helps identify and support those suffering mentally. Teen MHFA, aimed at secondary school students, includes classroom presentations and lots of activities.

Laura showed a brief video called 'Mate,' which is used to engage students in their discussions, helping them to look for warning signs in friends (thoughts, behaviours, feelings), then asking, listening and supporting their mates. Laura also highlighted the value of getting a suitable adult involved.

In general terms, those experiencing mental disability find it harder to maintain friendships and often have workplace and serious alcohol problems. Importantly, Laura told us that research now shows it is effective to ask someone suffering, 'Are you thinking about suicide?' The question itself does not promote suicide. If the

person says yes, then it is important to stay with them and listen without judging. If the situation is very serious, get help immediately, such as by taking them to a hospital or even calling for an ambulance or the police.

The presentation covered only one aspect of Dr Hart's ongoing research and, in answering many questions, her knowledge and understanding of public mental health issues was obvious ... as is her support of Australian Rotary Health. Thank you, Laura, for a brilliant and important address. *Thanks to Greg Ross (Host) for the report*

Geoff's Health Tip Medicinal Mushrooms




