Food is then sorted by Camcare staff for their 11:00 am distribution to the under privileged.

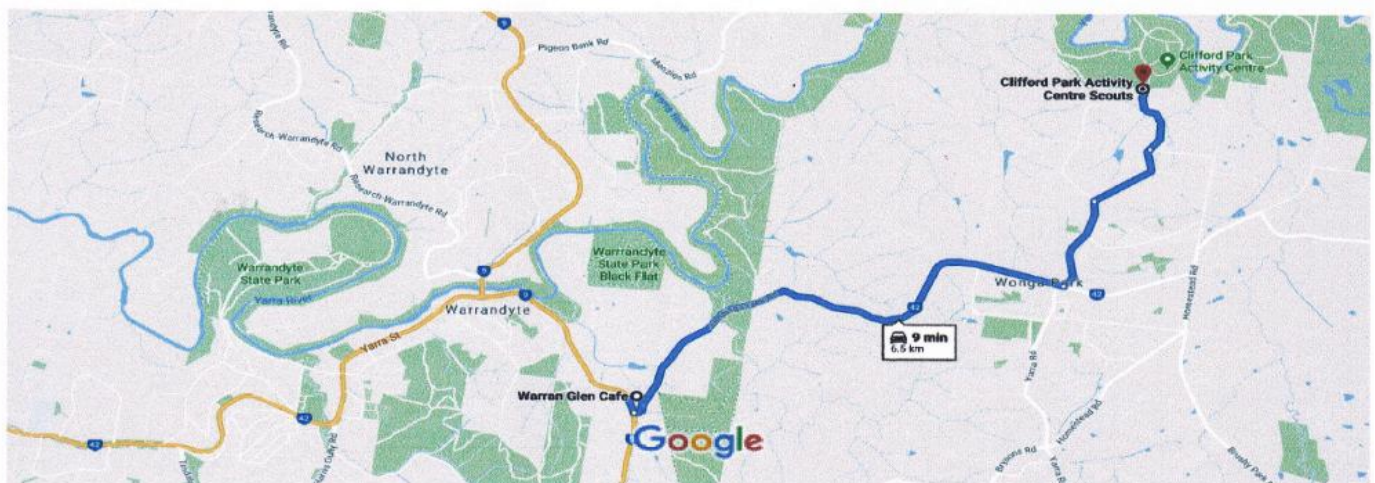

The Mongol bow is rated as effective as the English long bow with a firing distance of 500 yards and accurate to 200 yards with armour piercing capability.

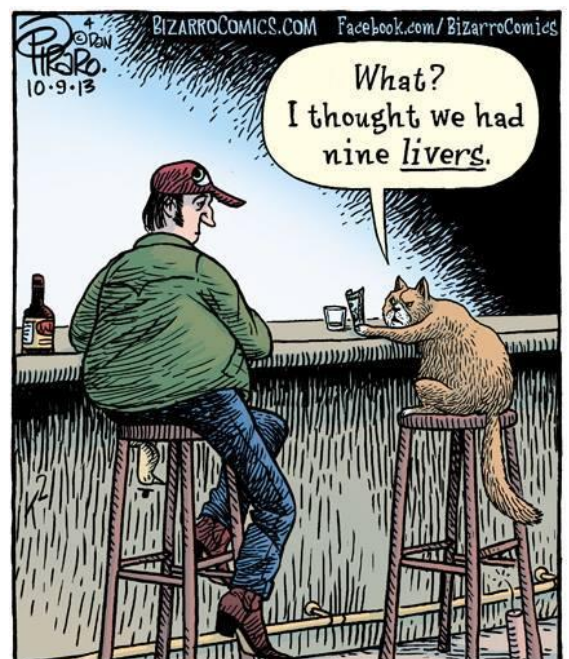
