

This photo shows Kyle with the subject for this painting.







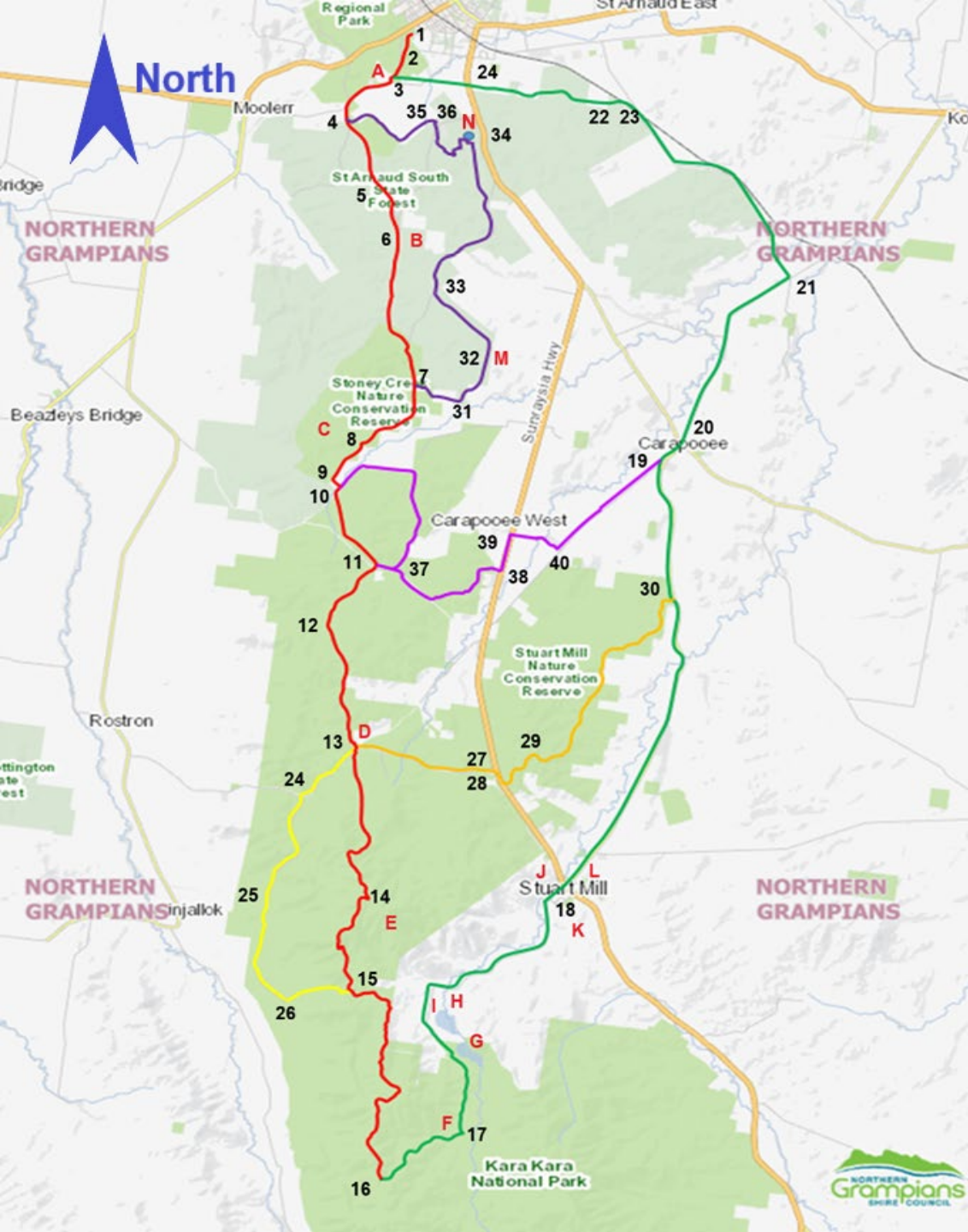


The St Arnaud Rotary Club created a bike trail about ten years ago.
