


Jerusalem Women Driving Health Together

A Rotary Global Grant Initiative Presented by Amy Zimmerman Rotary Club of Redondo Beach, D5280





Introduction

The "Jerusalem Women Driving Health Together" initiative is a community-led program aiming to become a Rotary Global Grant.

- Focus: Training 30 young Jewish and Arab women from Jerusalem as medics, ambulance drivers, and phlebotomists.
- **Goals:** Women empowerment, job creation, healthcare accessibility, and intercommunity collaboration.

Addressing Key Challenges



1. Healthcare Workforce Shortages

- Critical shortage of medics, ambulance drivers, and phlebotomists in East Jerusalem.
- High turnover rates and slow emergency response times.
- Magen David Adom (MDA) approached Rozana to launch this training program.

2. Women's Empowerment & Job Creation

Provides vocational skills and sustainable job opportunities.

3. Social Cohesion

- Integrated training sessions and 'other' language learning.
- Strengthens community ties between Jewish and Arab participants.

Implementation Plan

- Recruitment: Partner organizations select participants.
- **Training:** 6-month certified part-time course in emergency medical response and ambulance driving.
- 3-day phlebotomy course to boost employment prospects.
- Language Support: Hebrew and Arabic language classes to bridge communication gaps.
- **Job Placement:** Collaboration with MDA and other ambulance services to secure employment for graduates.

Project Timeline



- Recruitment & Language Training: 3 months
- Certification Training: 6 months (part-time)
- Job Placement, Alumni Development & Reporting: 3 months



Key Partners & Their Roles

Magen David Adom (MDA):

- National emergency medical service provider.
- Responsible for recruiting Jewish participants, training, and certification.

Lissan:

- Nonprofit promoting gender and social equality.
- Recruits Arab participants and provides Hebrew language training.

Rozana:

- Global health diplomacy organization.
- Oversees project implementation, monitoring, and sustainability planning.



Budget Breakdown

Total Budget: \$90,000 (\$3,000 per trainee)


• Training Programs: \$53,000

• Language Support: \$12,000


• Transportation: \$8,000

• Management, M&E, Contingency: \$15,000

• **Publicity:** \$2,000



Monitoring & Sustainability



- Monitoring: Track training completion and employment rates.
- Sustainability Strategies:
 - Ongoing professional development and employment through MDA.
 - Alumni network to mentor new participants and support community health initiatives.


