OUR DRESS CODE

All visitors to are required to maintain a standard of dress considered by the Committee to be, in both style and neatness, in keeping with the character and standing of the Club.

Golfers are to be aware of the following dress guidelines and ensure that they conform to these guidelines, which the staff are authorised by the Committee to administer.

Acceptable Dress

- Smart casual golf attire in all areas of the course and clubhouse.
- Collared Shirts (It is a requirement that men's shirts are tucked in).
- Tailored skirts, shorts and pants.
- Short socks provided they are golf specific and predominantly white and must always be worn with shorts.
- Regulation golf shoes are the only form of footwear accepted. Non-metal spikes are compulsory. Metal spikes are prohibited

<u>Unacceptable Dress</u>

- Denim (blue, black or moleskins).
- Cargo, sports shorts or tracksuit pants.
- Any garments carrying overt advertising slogans.
- Sandals and open footwear for men or loafers without socks.
- Golf caps with the peak not facing forward.
