Today's Competition Rules

Even though we are running a hole in one competition today, the normal rules as laid down by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews will apply. If you're in any doubt about any aspect of these rules, please ask one of the competition officials and they'll be happy to help.

Hole In One Competition Rules

When you make your attempt at the hole in one hole, please make sure that one of our competition officials is there to witness it. There will be a supervising Marshall at each prize hole. Each player is entitled to one shot at the hole at each prize.

Practice shots are not permitted, though practice swings are fine. Should you make a hole in one on the prize hole you must continue and complete the round in order to be eligible for the prize.

PUBLICITY

Players acknowledge and agree that participation in this event means that the Rotary Club of Glenferrie and Silver Star Motors Mercedes Benz may use their name and images in publicity material and for advertising purposes. Players also agree to make themselves reasonably available for publicity purposes.

WINNER

The first three registered players to hit a hole in one on one of the three prize holes, 5, 10 or 15, will be a winner. If there is more than one valid hole in one on a prize hole then each player who has scored a valid hole in one will be entitled to win a car.
