 - Name mention on the Rotary website, Community Garden page

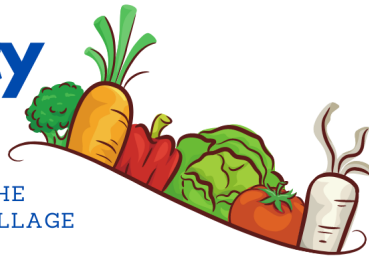
