



Creating A “My Rotary” Account & Making A Donation

- Go to [www.rotary.org](https://www.rotary.org/en) & click on “My Rotary”

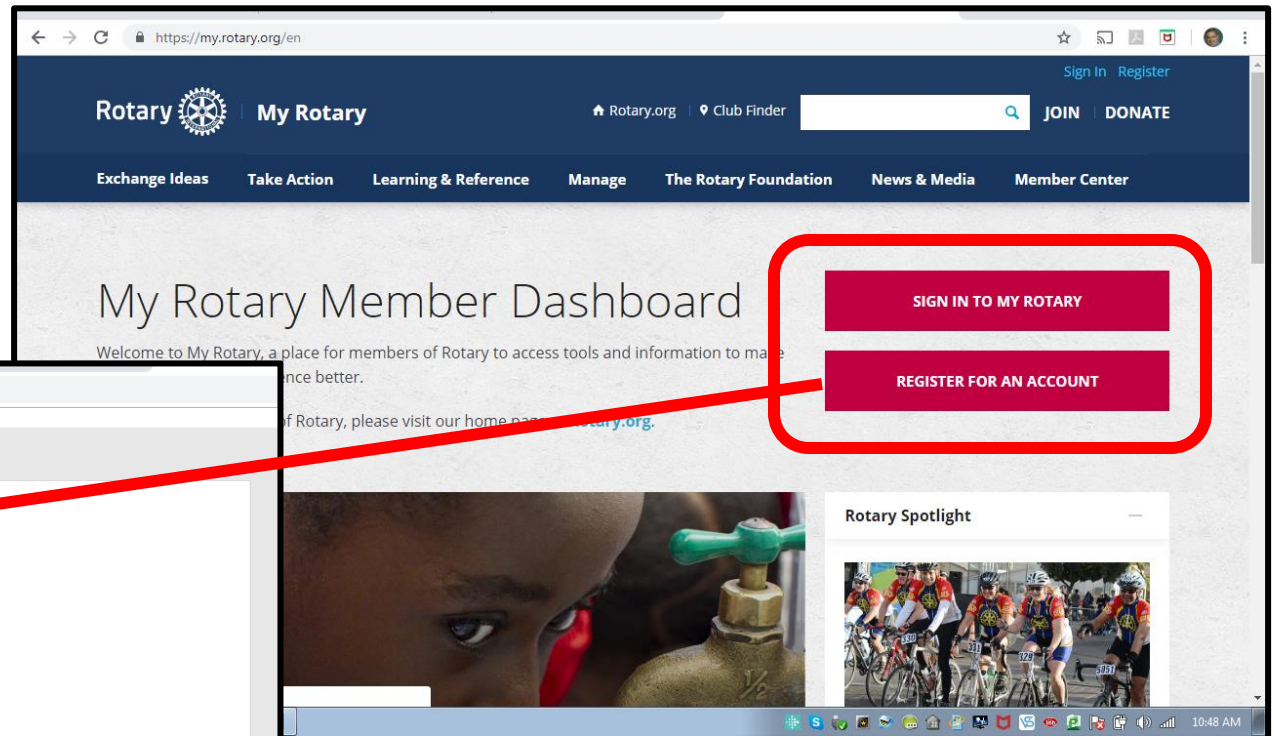

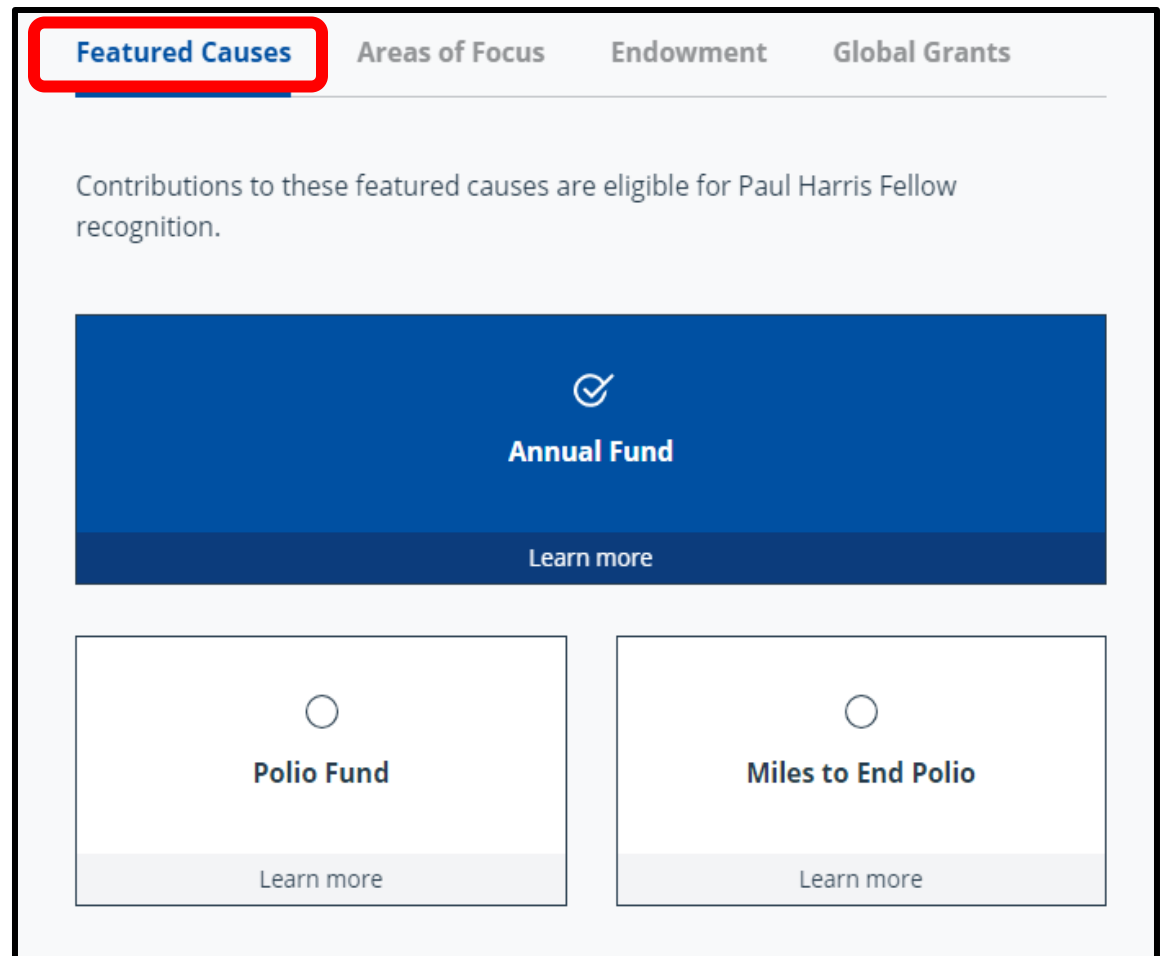
