

BOETTTLER PARK

THIS EASY LOOP GOES AROUND THE POND, PAST THE SOCCER FIELDS, AND THROUGH THE PRESERVED BOETTTLER PARK WETLAND.

KNAPP RECREATION AREA

A STATE PARK LOCATED IN GREEN WITH A MODERATE TRAIL THAT EXTENDS DOWN TO THE COTTAGE GROVE LAKE.

SOUTHGATE PARK

ADJACENT TO BOETTTLER PARK, MORE THAN 5 MILES OF TRAILS MEANDER THROUGH THIS NATURE PARK.

NIMISILA RESERVOIR

THIS PRISTINE RESERVOIR IS HOME TO MANY BIRDS AND WATERFOWL WILDLIFE ALL YEAR LONG. THE EASY WALKING TRAIL LINES THE WEST AND NORTH SIDE OF THE RESERVOIR.
