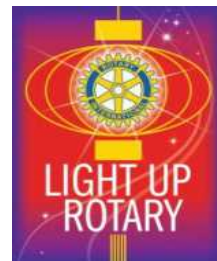

LINDSAY'S LINES

100 years ago the Australian Branch of the British Red Cross Society began, nine days after the outbreak of World War I. All it took were letters from the wife of the Governor General at the time to all State Governors' wives asking for support. As Qld. Divisional Chair, John Pinney AM, outlined to us last week, Red Cross of today has a wide range of programs with many running locally here in Qld. A national decision in 9 days in 1914 is extraordinary. Imagine if they had today's technology! Just shows what can be done if someone simply asks.

Red Cross reminded me of so many Rotary attributes such as international and its focus of service to others, regardless of their background. A classic example is the international program that support girls gaining education in Cambodia, the Life & Hope Association, that John Ker announced our club will become the new proud Rotary sponsors.

Then the real connect with the Red Cross was when Russell Postle outlined the exciting project we are working towards – establishing a unique 100th ANZAC anniversary memorial and display for the famous shipwreck on Fraser Island, the Maheno. Having been used as a hospital ship off ANZAC Cove in 1915 (repainted white overall, with a broad green stripe along her sides, and large "red crosses" on the sides and funnels), this NZ ocean liner is a relic with a direct link to the Gallipoli campaign right here on our home shores. We aim to celebrate and leave a memorial of the lasting bond we have with our NZ cousins that was epitomised on the shores of Gallipoli all those years ago.
