Edna Adan was the first girl in Somaliland to learn to read, the first Somali wor to drive a car, the country's first certifled nurse-midwife, and, as wife of Presid Ibrahim Egal, the First Lady of Somalia.


Raised in an educated and wealthy family. Edna worked as a student teacher Raised in an educated and wealthy family, Edna worked as a student feacher when a girls 'school fist opened in Somaliand, gaing on to become the fist Somali girl awarded a scholarship to study nursing, midwllery and hospital management in Bitlain. Returning to Somaliand after seven years, she worked for the World Health Organization in various key positions, advocating for the abolition of traditional practices such as female genital cutting. On retirement, she sold all of her possessions and returned to Somaliand to realise her life-long dream of building the country's first maternity hospital.
