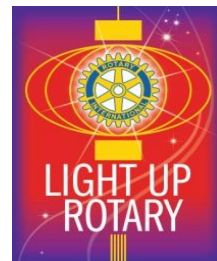

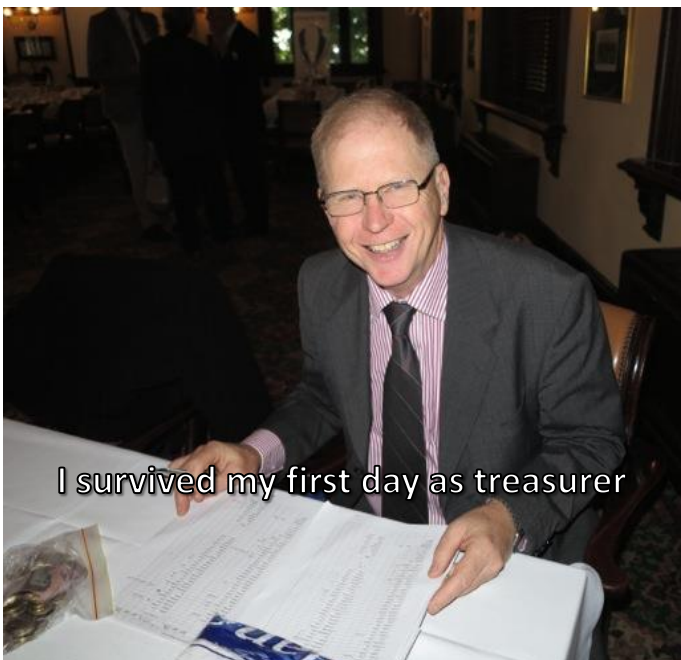

(Rotary Youth Leadership Awards)

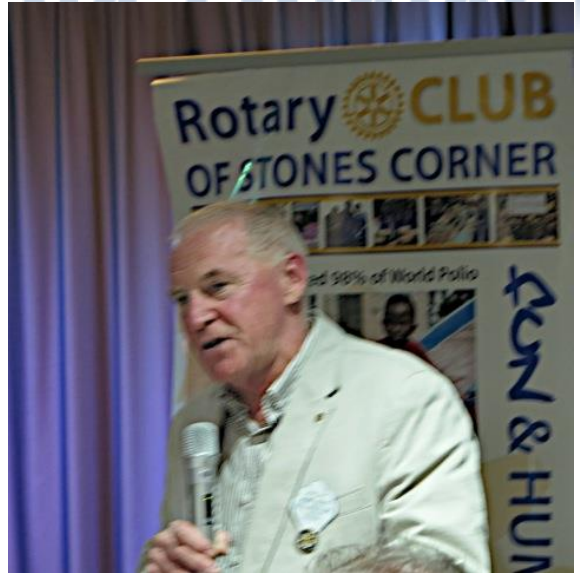
