

### WENDY'S WISDOM

Last week was unusual in that it included days when we celebrated Happiness and the National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence. It's important to realise that young children are learning to cope with both and it makes for an interesting time for someone in my role when I'm doing media about both. A couple of times I picked up the phone, the recording starts and I wasn't totally sure about which of the spectrum I was being asked about. How's this for a question to answer – To help children and young people become more resilient should we tell them to be more active whenever opportunities arise? (What – to dance more or to bully the bully?).

During a Townsville talk back session it was mentioned that the front page of the paper featured a photo of two young girls walking home from school and being bullied – verbally and physically – by some others. We discussed some of the actions that can be taken but I wanted to remind everyone in our Club that two things happen very often with bullying. The first is that it gets hidden as people are scared of the consequences for them and the second is that as adults we often see or hear of bullying happening and don't take any action at all. Don't hide bullying and don't look the other way. Don't let being bullied make you a victim. As Rotarians we work to make our community a better and safer place – we should remember that doesn't necessarily mean it has to take place when we organise activities as a group – as we go about our everyday lives we should be watching for ways to participate in making Brisbane a happier place for all.


