



On Sunday, Diane and I took our Danish Exchange student, Emilie, to Lone Pine Koala Sanctuary. Hidden away on the banks of the Brisbane River, less than 25 minutes from the CBD, is a zoo of truly international repute. It is the largest koala sanctuary in the world and one of the few Australian zoos that allow you to feed and touch the animals, let alone cuddle a koala. Yet it is 25 years since I last went there and my son Scott didn't think it was cool to join us "doing the tourist thing" even though he has just arrived home after "doing all the tourist things" in his 8 months in Europe! Emilie now has cuddled a koala; fed kangaroos, emus and rainbow lorikeets; watched a bird of prey demonstration followed by a sheep dog trial; and viewed platypus, dingoes, Tasmanian Devils and a myriad of native birds. Emilie has also reminded me that we take our "local backyard" for granted. We indeed live in an amazing city in a truly world-class region.


