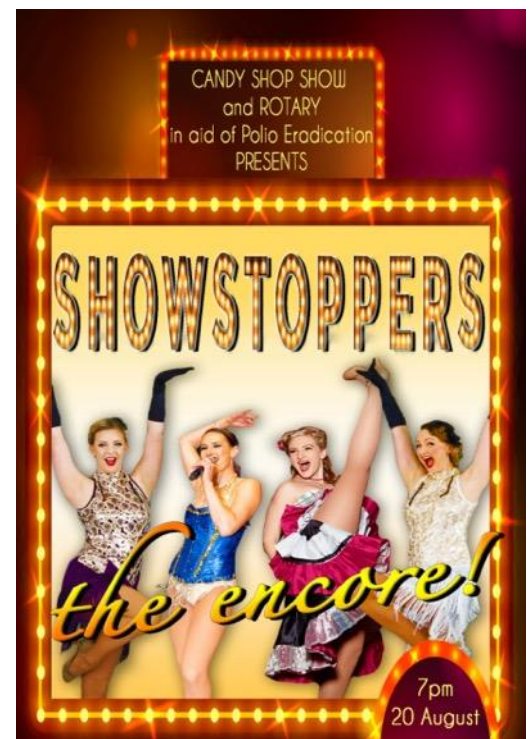

MAHENO BELL GOES ON TOUR



Camerata is the Qld String orchestra. Each year they commission a piece to take on their regional tour. BDO became a sponsor of Camerata late last year when Susan Rix and I met with them. Susan shared the story of the Maheno, the bronze plaque on the island and the replica bell (We were about to leave for NZ to unveil the copy of the plaque in the town of Maheno).

Camerata decided to use the Maheno, Fraser Island and the bell as the focus of this year's commissioned piece. The Composer visited the island, (we hosted them at the Retreat) travelled around with a Butchulla elder and was completely inspired by the island and especially the bell. They have now completed the piece and the replica bell from the Retreat will travel with Camerata on their 2019 regional tour
